1st race *** FIRST POST TIME 12:30 PM ***

| 1. Farley Hall (#1) | 8/5 |
| 2. Freedom of Speech (#2) | 2/1 |
| 3. Sir Nano (#6) | 7/2 |

Droppers get first call. **Farley Hall** is fit exiting a route & should have enough early zip to give these the slip. **Freedom of Speech** another moving turf to dirt & route to sprint. Lack of early pace is biggest concern. **Sir Nano** should get nice outside pressing trip.

2nd race

| 2. Thetribehasspoken (#2) | 7/2 |
| 3. Rosa Parks (#3) | 3/1 |

We the Hobby tried hard when holding place money vs. this kind in debut. She took right to the turf & shorter trip seems a plus. **Thetribehasspoken** won't have to be a monster to make impact in debut. Hernandez gets the call. **Rosa Parks** disappointed when favored in debut..

3rd race

| 2. Touchdown Brown (#1) | 3/1 |
| 3. Saqeel (#4) | 7/2 |

El Rey Dorado drops in for a tag, gets Lasix back, & could get brave if able to make the early lead. **Touchdown Brown** is this kind on turf horse – toss out last. He can handle two turns and Fresu opts for him over **Speed Crazy**. **Saqeel** just missed at SA Oct 6 but did not get back on the work tab until Nov 4. Fitness a question.

4th race

| 3. Belmont Bill (#2) | 4/1 |

Tizz a Good Thing turned in improved work with blinkers on Nov 17 and adds them to race today. **Caribbean King** took right to the sprint game in Maiden win. Is 5f too short for his late run? **Belmont Bill** always in the hunt but is very camera shy. Tough to trust.

5th race

She's No Angel has worked better than she has run so far. Maybe class drop and rider switch to Hernandez will wake her up. **Running Super** may be best with a patient ride. Good post switch. **Matina** has speed & is bred to like the dirt. Glatt barn is on a roll.

6th race

Miso Phansy is out of a debut winner and related to four turf winners. Barn not known for firing first time out but work pattern is solid. **Lil' Boom Boom** has turf in female family but has been runner-up in four straight. **Maga Kai** perked up working on tapeta at SA. She should like the turf.

7th race

| 3. Barbera (#4) | 9/2 |

Nene Diamond beat this kind on turf & was easy Maiden winner in debut on dirt. She still has upside. **Wishtheyallcouldbe** was a voided claim when beaten this kind here in Sept and has healthy work tab for return. Tough when she breaks cleanly. **Barbera** opened a big lead & was run down on the wire vs. similar at SA.

8th race

| 3. Dr. Soulfire (#7) | 5/1 |

Mega Moon is fresh and figures to stalk the pace and get first run on the closers. **Sbagliato** was beaten a neck when favored vs. this kind at SA. One to beat. **Dr. Soulfire** had sprint prep and is bred to like two turns. **Flint Stroll** showed signs of life in last.

NEWS AND NOTES

The rails are 30 feet out from their normal position on the turf...The main track and turf course played fair last weekend...First post time 12:30 pm...**NOTE: Speed Crazy (#6)** has been entered back on Saturday and will likely be a late scratch from today's 3rd race...Very happy to see **Santa Anita** has re-named the Gr. II San Antonio Stakes. It will now be called the **Gr. II Laffit Pincay Jr. Stakes** and will be run opening day Dec 26...**Umberto Rispoli** has nine wins to lead the jockeys, followed closely by **Juan Hernandez (8)**, **Antonio Fresu (8)**, and **Tiago Pereira (7)**. **Tyler Baze** is winless at the meet from 35 mounts...**Mark Glatt** leads all trainers with seven wins, followed by **Doug O'Neill (5)**, **Michael McCarthy (4)**, **Peter Miller (4)**, **George Papaprodromou (4)**, **Steve Miyadi (4)**, and **Phil D'Amato (4)**. Favorites are winning at a 35% clip for the meet. **Lindo Report Update: Thru Sunday (92 races), the top selection has won 34 times (37%) for total mutuels of \$240.80 – a flat-bet profit and R.O.I. of \$1.31 for each \$1 wagered.**
