| 3. Running Spartan (#3) | 7/2 |
- Money Makes Money** tried hard when 2nd best vs. this kind off layoff at SA. He likes the DMR turf & should be set for best. **Laugier Night** prefers this course over SA and should get nice inside stalking trip. **Running Spartan** will be running late.

2nd race

- Dial a Friend** has speed, cozy outside post, is best on dirt, drops into a restricted claimer for first time, & gets Hernandez. Much in her favor. **Dr. Ray D.** has a chance to tag a lot of tiring speed. **Beau Soleil** drops into restricted claimer, is fresh, & could wake up if she breaks cleanly. Recent works are fast for Hess barn.

- Got'm Cot'm** adds blinkers & drops in with Maidens after ducking in at start of Golden State Juvenile. Expect more early speed. **Letmein** has good race over track & should get nice outside pressing trip. **Thirsty Mufasa** lost all chance with poor start & wide trip at Los Al. Look for him to go from rail post.

- Nine-year-old **Exultation** will be ineligible to run at SA next year at age 10. He fires every time & is the sentimental pick. **Russells Hustle** has suddenly won two straight. Confidence sky high. **Evening Sun** has been racing into shape. He could be set now.

She adds blinkers & must be caught. **Mad Pursuit** has work ready pattern at San Luis Rey for barn not known for popping with first-time starters. **American Blessing** was distant 2nd in slow race for this kind in debut.

7th race *** GRADE III RED CARPET STAKES ***

- First look to the shippers. **Forever After All** is camera shy, but she missed by a nose in the Gr. III Dowager at this trip at KEE, ran well when shipped to Ca for the Gamely at SA, & catches a modest group. **Marksman Queen** also proven at 12f trip & will get first run on top choice. **Mrs. Astor** ran OK when shipped here last summer.

- Love Our Family** should be able to control the pace from rail post and won both starts this summer over this course & distance. **Stop Digging** has been in the exacta in six of seven lifetime starts. **Satellite Heart** beat this kind on turf last time & is a multiple winner on dirt.

- Dealers Special** has been sharp all year and was unlucky to lose vs. similar here in Sept. **Big Juanito** is slowly improving and should be rolling late. **Rastaman Vibe** had no excuse when beaten a neck dropping to this level at SA. **Cupid's Crusader**, **Baldoro**, and **One Time Mark** make this an interesting finale.
