3★ BEST BET

COLORADO over Arizona by 3

The Buffaloes host the Wildcats in Boulder in their final home game of the season with nasty 21-point revenge foremost on their minds from a 76-55 beat down in Tucson six weeks ago in a contest that saw Arizona pull away by 17 points in the second-half, when Colorado finished just 4 for 20 from three-point range. Meanwhile, Arizona takes the floor having sewn up the top-seed in the Pac-12 tourney knowing they are 3-8 ATS in this series when coming off consecutive wins, including **0-5 ATS** when arriving off an ATS win. On the flip side, Colorado takes the floor off Thursday night's 17-point upset at home to Arizona State with a 11-3 SU and 10-4 ATS home ledger in conference games when coming off a home loss. With that we'll sign, seal, and deliver this package with added assistance from **THE CLINCHER: Colorado is 11-4 SU and 12-3 ATS in Last Home Games, including 10-2 SU and 11-1 ATS when the Buffaloes own a sub .690 win percentage.**

4★ BEST BET

NORTHERN IOWA over Loyola Chicago by 10

This is the battle for the No. 1 seed in next week's MVC tourney, as both teams enter this fray with identical 13-4 ledgers in the Valley. The incentive arrow points to the Panthers, who were laid out, 85-58, in the Windy City two weeks ago – the worst loss in this series since at least 1990. It's also Senior Night in Cedar Falls, where a veteran 5-returning starter UNI squad brings an 11-3 SU and 10-4 ATS mark in Last Home Games into this contest, including **6-1 ATS** when not favored by six or more points. Meanwhile, the Ramblers have not fared well when facing foes playing with same season revenge from a loss of 20-plus points, going just 2-7 ATS as visitors. In summary, this is where we lean on our learned friend, **THE CLINCHER: Loyola is 4-17-1 ATS against avenging opponents the past two seasons, including 0-8-1 ATS when the Ramblers are coming off a SUATS win.**

Monday, February 28

TEXAS TECH over Kansas State by 21

The Red Raiders pull down the final curtain on Senior Night in Lubbock, where they will look to improve on a **5-0 SUATS** record

The Philadelphia 76ers are 33-0 ATS in SU away victories in which they are seeking revenge for a pair of same-season losses.



at home in this series when seeking revenge in games in which the Wildcats enter with a fewer than .666 win percentage. The revenge occurs from a 62-51 loss they incurred at Kansas State as 4.5-point chalk six weeks ago. That sets the table for the fact that TTRR sports a 14-3 ATS overall mark at home this season, including **8-0 ATS** in Big 12 battles, as well as a **7-0 ATS** record this campaign when looking to avenge a previous loss. Toss in a **7-1-1 ATS** log in Last Home Games and suddenly it appears as though the Wildcats' 1-4 SU record in conference road finales against avenging rivals is about to take another hit.

Tuesday, March 1

KENTUCKY over Ole Miss by 24

Lo and behold, it's John Calipari back in his comfortable favorite role tonight, looking to make amends for an SEC conference loss where he brings a 42-9 SU and 30-21 ATS record into tonight's skirmish, including 25-9 ATS when his troops are coming off consecutive wins in avenger roles. The revenge in question is from a 70-62 hiccup in Oxford when these two rivals met last season. Given Kentucky's cool 27-4 SU record in LHG's (Last Home Games), we turn our attention to the fact that the cool cats are 18-9 ATS in LHG wins. The Rebels oblige in LRG's (Last Road Games), going just 1-4 SUATS the past five seasons. Considering Kentucky's 88-39-3 ATS record in SU revenge victories, there is only one way to look here tonight.

Wednesday, March 2

5★ BEST BET

MISSISSIPPI STATE over Auburn by 8

A key battle between these dogs and cats with Auburn looking to stave off Kentucky for the top-seed in the conference, while MSU finds itself in a ferocious battle with five teams for the 5th seed in the upcoming SEC tourney. The Bulldogs have done their best work in Starkville this season where they stand 14-2 SU and 11-5 ATS, including **6-1 SUATS** in conference play at press time. While Auburn has lingered near or at the top of the rankings this season, they are beginning to show signs of wear, going just 1-4-1 ATS in their previous six contests at press time, while the visiting team is only 6-19-1 ATS in Tiger tiffs this season. Given Mississippi State head coach Ben Howland's 50-32-2 ATS career mark at home when seeking revenge, including 18-11-1 ATS when taking points, along with his 15-5 SUATS record in LHG's – including **14-2 SUATS** in games in which his troops possess a .482 or better win percentage, it's time we hand it off to **THE CLINCHER: Mississippi State is 6-0 ATS as a dog in Last Home Games since 1993.**

4★ BEST BET

Brooklyn over MILWAUKEE by 6

Embattled Bucks are finding it difficult playing with the "defending champion" target on their backs this season. For openers, they are just 10-20 ATS in their last twenty home games this campaign, including 3-13 ATS against .500 or greater foes. Meanwhile, the new-look Nets will be out to avenge not only a pair of same-season defeats at the hands of Milwaukee tonight, but also a 7-game playoff series loss to the Bucks last season as well. With Brooklyn 10-5-2 ATS away in conference play this season, the points become the play tonight. And so says **THE CLINCHER: See Marc's AWESOME ANGLE on page 2.**

This issue contains 4 of our 17 Major Conference Tournament previews.

(1) HORIZON LEAGUE

Tuesday, March 1 - Mon/Tue, March 7-8 • Games at campus sites, then Indiana Farmers Coliseum • Indianapolis, IN

PLAYBOOK PROJECTED FINAL FOUR: CLEVELAND STATE • OAKLAND • WRIGHT STATE • NO KENTUCKY

TECH NOTES: DKY round favorites of 10 < pts are 17-4-2 ATS... 1ST round dogs of > 6 pts are 9-2 ATS... SEM round favs off an ATS loss are 7-2 ATS... FNL round favs of 2 > pts are 4-0 ATS L5Y... #1 seeds off BB SUATS wins are 0-6 ATS... #2 seed home teams are 0-5 ATS... #3 seeds are 23-12 ATS (17-6 off BB SU wins... #4 seeds off a SU loss are 6-0-1 ATS... #8 or worse seed dogs 10 < pts are 6-18-1 ATS.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: Rest assured, only the winning team in this event will be dancing in March. Last season top-seeded **CLEVELAND STATE** climbed the ladder, and cut down the nets, marking the first time in 14 years that the No. 1 seed emerged victorious. Simply put, the 5-returning starter Vikings are the team to beat once again this season. SG D'Moi Hodge leads this guard oriented squad charge, with their top 5 scorers each operating out of the backcourt... **OAKLAND** fell in last year's title game, 80-69, but the Grizzlies' previous 5 tourney losses had been by a total of only 10 points, with 3 one-point losses prior to last season. They are Ken Pom's top-rated team in the loop... **WRIGHT STATE** has made it to the finals in 5 of the last 9 years in this event, and stands 18-14 SU and 18-13-1 ATS overall in this tourney, including 15-7 SU and 14-7-1 ATS when laying points... **NORTHERN KENTUCKY** is always a threat in this tournament, winning 9 of the 12 games they've played since joining the Horizon in 2016.



Senior guard D'Moi Hodge is the key to Cleveland State's league-leading 77 PPG attack.

The Norsemen have saddled up as underdog only four times in this tourney, while winning three of the games straight up.

THE SLEEPER: PURDUE-FORT WAYNE

The Mastodons returned 4 starters from last year's squad who joined the Horizon for the first time last season, only to have six consecutive games cancelled, and six players quarantined a combined 60 days due to COVID. Head coach Jon Coffman's troops were 13-6 SU and 14-5 ATS in league games this campaign and should be considered dangerous.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET: PLAY ON DONKEY ROUND FAVORITES OF 10 OR FEWER POINTS

As our TECH NOTES above point out, manageable favorites in the Donkey Round of this event have rewarded backers handsomely. FYI: They also improve to 14-2-2 ATS when facing foes off a loss.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: Sister Jean blessed her beloved No. 1 seed **LOYOLA CHICAGO** team in last year's tourney, and it all worked out in the Ramblers' favor when they bested No. 2 seed Drake in the title game before eventually bowing out in the Sweet 16 Round of the NCAA Tournament. In the process head coach Porter Moses moved on to guide Oklahoma, leaving his top assistant, Drew Valentine, to assume the reins. It's worked well, as the 26-win Ramblers welcomed 4 starters back en route to capturing the top seed in this year's event. And they stand 7-1 SU and 6-2 ATS as a No. 1 seed in this event. Yes, they are a blessed team and indeed the one to beat again this year... **DRAKE** enters this fray with five starters back from last year's runner-up squad, which automatically paints them as dangerous. The Bulldogs were the preseason choice to win the MVC this season, and they can cash that ticket here. It should be noted, though, that last season they were 17-1 SU and 15-2-1 ATS as favorites of a dozen or fewer points. This season, though, they regressed to the mean, going 5-5 SU and 2-8 ATS (at press time). Nonetheless, they are 6-2 ATS the last eight games in this tourney, and are a threat to climb the ladder this year... **MISSOURI STATE** was slotted as the No. 3 choice in this tournament last season. They bowed out

in the second-round to Drake, as they disappointingly concluded their season at 17-7. With all 5 starters back this year, they figure to be out for Bear this go-round. Remember, they are 30-6 SU and 25-10-1 ATS at press time as a favorite the past two seasons... Yet another 5-returning starter squad, **NORTHERN IOWA**, was the preseason 3rd choice in the loop this year, and the Panthers bring plenty of MVC tourney pedigree, winning 10 of their past 14 contests while going 14-8-1 ATS a dog. Color them dangerous.

THE SLEEPER: SOUTHERN ILLINOIS

The Salukis were in this same spot last season, before they were sent packing in the second round by eventual winner Loyola. Note: They were 7-1 ATS in MVC play when coming off a loss this season, and are 17-5 SU and 13-8-1 ATS in this extravaganza when facing sub .550 foes.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET: PLAY ON THE NO. 1 SEED IN THEIR FIRST GAME

As we've said many times on this page in the past, the numbers don't lie. No. 1 seeds in this tourney are a jaw-dropping 31-1 SU and 22-9-1 ATS in opening round games after Loyola leveled Southern Illinois, 73-49 last year. You know what to do.

TECH NOTES: Favorites w/ same-season revenge are 12-1 ATS... DKY round favs are 3-11 ATS L11Y... 1ST round dogs off a DD SU win are 11-1 ATS... SEM round favs 10 < pts are 18-9-1 ATS... FNL round favs < 14 pts are 7-0 ATS L9Y... #1 seed favs < 13 pts are 20-7 ATS all-time (8-1 L9)... #2 seed teams off a DD SU win are 1-8-2 ATS L9Y... #4 seeds are 11-22-1 ATS all-time (0-5-2 ATS L4Y).

THE WAY WE SEE IT: For the seventh time in the last eight years, the first two teams slotted into our Final Four are the same teams. And just as we called out on these pages last year, it all starts where it has since what seems like the days of James Naismith with **GONZAGA** the leader of the pack. The Bulldogs have won this tourney 16 of the last 19 years, while arriving to the title game all twenty seasons. With it, the Zags are 47-5 SU and 31-20-1 ATS in this event, including 33-0 SU against No. 3 or worse opponents. As a result, they will look to earn a coveted No. 1 seed in the Big Dance for the fifth time in the last six years. One note of interest: the G-Men have been installed as favorites of 24 or more points three times in this event. They won and covered all three games by an average score of 96-63. You're on your own fading them here...

SAINT MARY'S earned back the No. 2 position in the year's seeding when the five returning starters from last year's unit refused to lose consecutive games, going 6-0 SUATS off a loss. The Gaels, though, are just 5-10-2 ATS in their last seventeen games in this tournament, as well as 1-11 SUATS when taking 6 or more points in this event... Thanks to a 10-0 start this season, **SAN FRANCISCO** was vastly improved this campaign. They paid the price for their success, though, going just 2-12 ATS when coming off consecutive wins. However, the opposite

holds true for the Dons in this tourney where they stand 12-3 ATS when playing off a pair of wins... Last season **BYU** advanced to the Big Dance for the first time since 2015, and then proceeded to lose in the first round. After winning 16 of their first 20 games this campaign, the Cougars hit the wall dropping 5 of their next 7 games (at press time). The biggest hurdle they face in this, their final WCC Tourney (the Mormons will join the Big 12 next season), is the fact that they are 4-14-2 ATS all-time in this tournament, including 0-9-2 ATS when coming off a win of more than 6 points.

THE SLEEPER: SANTA CLARA

The Broncos are peaking at the right time, going 10-5 SU and 10-4-1 ATS down the stretch at press time. They were also 13-5 ATS when coming off a win this season, and are 6-0 ATS when coming off consecutive SUATS wins in this tourney.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET:

PLAY ON ANY FAVORITE WITH SAME-SEASON REVENGE

Safe to say this tourney has been a chalk lovers' haven, with favorites going 91-70-6 ATS overall, including 77-45-5 ATS when favored by fewer than 12 points. However, when any of these favorites is looking to avenge a same-season loss, they zoom to 12-1 SUATS. Enough said.

TECH NOTES: Favorites are 21-5-1 ATS vs an opponent off SU dog win... DKY round teams off DD ATS win are 0-5 ATS... 1ST round favs are 22-9 ATS all-time (12-3 L5Y)... FNL round favs are 4-1 ATS L5Y... #1 seed favs > 5 pts are 2-7 ATS L8Y... #2 seed teams off a DD ATS win are 1-5 ATS... #3 seeds are 1-6 ATS vs opponent w/ revenge... #5 seeds are 2-9 ATS L7Y... #8 or worse seed dogs are 8-19 ATS.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: The Sun Belters return to the Pensacola Bay Center for the second-straight year, only this time every game will be held here this year, as opposed to 2021 when the opening round games were held at campus sites. Once again, this league is the weakest of all Division-1 conferences, and the winner of this tournament is a likely one-and-done in the Big Dance. However, as Martin Luther King once said, "I have a dream" lives on in the Sun Belt. And like last season, **TEXAS STATE** holds down the top spot among this year's Final Four. It didn't help the Bobcats, who fell as the No. 1 seed to eventual champion Appalachian State in the first round. Nevertheless, TSU is 9-4 ATS all-time in this tourney. They entered the final week of the regular season on a seven-game win skein, but were 0-5 SUATS this campaign against greater than .600 opponents. Remember, No. 1 seeds who were one-and-dones the previous season play with huge revenge chips on their shoulders... **SOUTH ALABAMA** was Ken Pom's top-rated team in the loop this season but was just 3-4 against winning opposition at press time. Interestingly, USA stands 11-6 ATS a favorite, but only 8-13 ATS as a dog in Sun Belt tourney games. They are 41-30-3 ATS in conference games under 4th-year head coach Richie Riley, including 18-7-1 ATS when seeking revenge against fellow Sun Belters... **APPALACHIAN STATE** started the season like a tortoise,

going just 3-8 in its first eleven contests before picking up the pace in January. They did struggle, though, against greater than .600 opponents, going 2-8 SU and 3-7 ATS overall. The Mountaineers cut down the nets in last year's tourney, and are 5-1 SUATS in this tournament against foes entering off a SUATS win... **GEORGIA STATE** has been a long-time staple in this tourney. The Panthers welcome back five starters from last year's squad, and after a lethargic 6-10 beginning to the season, the veteran leadership took over as they entered the final week of the regular season riding a 5-0 SUATS win skein. A 10-5 SU all-time mark in this event is noteworthy

THE SLEEPER: TROY

The Trojans are another 5-returning starter squad rebounding from an 11-win effort last season to a 16-win campaign at press time. They ride a 7-3 SU and 8-2 ATS mark in this tourney since 2013, including 7-0 SU and 6-1 ATS versus sub .666 foes.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET:

PLAY AGAINST TEAMS OFF A SU UNDERDOG WIN

Sun Belters tend to party a little too hard in games following an upset win in this tourney. That's confirmed by the fact that they are just 11-38 SU and 17-32-1 ATS in all games since 2000, including 1-12 SU and 2-11 ATS in follow-up games the last seven years.
