COLLEGE BASKETBALL

Saturday, January 28

INDIANA STATE over Northern Iowa by 13

Right away you're probably thinking we've signed up for a ride on the Crazy Train with Ozzy. After all, the hometown Sycamores have dropped five straight on the scoreboard while the defending Missouri Valley Conference champion Panthers have won 7 of their last eight. Two teams in opposite directions, right? A closer look, though, points out why we think Indiana State will be lying in wait today. Two losses last season at the hands of Northern Iowa cost 'Larry Bird U' a chance at eclipsing the 11-win plateau under first-year head coach Josh Schertz, a successful NCAA Division II coach. The last time the Sycamores won fewer games was during the 2003-04 season, a fact that really upset Schertz. It's evident this season as his troops have won 13 games thus far with seven of their top nine players back, including all five starters. Yes, the 5-game losing skid is a concern, but this has been one streaky campaign for ISU, who opened 2-1, then went 5-0, 0-3, 3-1 and 0-5. No worries about a lookahead here with Evansville up next, a foe the Sycamores vanquished in late December, 91-63. The WOM (Well-Oiled Machine) informs us that Indiana State is **16-4-1 ATS** at home in this series when seeking revenge, and that UNI's 3-8 SUATS mark in this series when ISU is seeking double revenge from the previous season goes hand-in-hand with their long-term 13-35 SUATS record against all foes playing with double revenge from the previous campaign. That's all the ammo we need. Like Ozzy loves to say, "All aboard!"

WISCONSIN over Illinois by 8

We hope you checked with the conductor for a ticket upgrade because it looks like we'll be taking an extended ride on the Crazy Train to Madison, Wisconsin. Let's review: not only have the Badgers been bullied in their previous six games this year, going 1-5 SU and 0-6 ATS, they've also gone a pitiful 0-5 SUATS in the last five series games with Illinois. The Illini have been taking care of business lately, currently on a 5-1 SUATS run, but the fact of the matter is their luck runs out today. For one thing, Wisconsin posted 25 wins last season, and prior to the recent losses to Illinois, the Badgers were 36-20 SU and 37-17-1 ATS in the series – including 13-0 SU and 12-1 ATS the previous thirteen contests. Thus, it's time for a "what goes down, must come up" situation for the home team. Illinois is coming off a revenge win over Ohio State on Tuesday and is a weak **2-8 SUATS** away after post-OSU wins. Then there's the Illini's meager 2-6 SUATS away mark coming off a win when facing greater than .600 foes this season. Remember, too, that the Illini's recent success means we'll get a good price on the game. It all reminds us of the film 'Patton', where the General's command post is strafed by a Nazi fighter plane, causing George C. Scott to bolt out into the street and challenge the aircraft with nothing but a pistol. Why? Because he'd HAD ENOUGH. That's the sort of crazy we expect out of Bucky here!

3★ BEST BET

DAYTON over Richmond by 17

A slow 3-4 start to the season was not what Dayton fans expected to see from a Flyers squad that notched 24 wins last year. Then the five returning Flyers' starters went to work, rebounding with a torrid 7-0 SUATS win skein in mid-December before recent road setbacks at Rhode Island and George Washington. Another rebound looks to be in order as the Flyers return to UD Arena, where they own a legitimate home court advantage. Dayton has gone 22-2 SU in its last 24 games at home, including 10-1 SU this season where the Flyers have won by an average margin of just over 16 PPG. And when it comes to dueling with foes that own a sub .525 win percentage, Dayton has treated its backers to a 13-0 SU and 9-3 ATS effort. We can't say the same for the 11-10 Spiders, who arrive on a 1-3 SU and 0-4 ATS slide in their last four games. Even worse, Richmond has gone **0-6 ATS** versus foes coming off consecutive losses, including **0-4 ATS** this season. Yikes. The hosts are hanging tough in the Atlantic 10 race in 4th place and will be facing a bunch of Spiders that could be more concerned about an upcoming double-revenger against St. Bonaventure. Of course, we can't wrap things up without **THE CLINCHER: Dayton's 68-64 loss to Richmond in the semifinals of the Atlantic-10 tourney last season snapped a 7-0 SUATS series win skein against the Spiders.**

4★ BEST BET

Michigan State over PURDUE by 1

Meet this week's new No. 1 – the Purdue Boilermakers. The only loss this season by the powerful 20-1 Boilers was a 1-point setback here against Rutgers the day following New Year's Day, and with Thursday's 75-70 revenge win over Michigan, Matt Painter's boys pushed their current win streak to 7 games. However, Purdue now carries a 'Target' size bullseye on its back, and few head coaches are better at bringing down big game than Michigan State's Tom Izzo. Yes, this is the spot where major upsets occur, and with it we'll be front and center with the Wizard of Iz. Sparty suffered a 64-63 setback at home to Purdue just 13 days ago, stirring up bad memories of being booted from the Big Ten tourney in the semifinals by the Makers last season. The Wizard brings a lofty 18-10 SU and 17-11 ATS career record in conference games when seeking same-season revenge when his troops are coming off an ATS loss, including 5-2 SUATS versus .800 or greater opposition. State's biggest concern will be putting the clamps on Purdue center Zach Edey, a 7-4, 305-pound monster from Toronto who averages 21 PPG and pulls down 13 rebounds. Still, the Boilermakers haven't cashed a ticket in the last three meetings with MSU, which is a perfect setup for **THE CLINCHER: See this week's AWESOME ANGLE on page 2.**

UPSET GAME OF THE WEEK UPSET

TEXAS TECH over Iowa State by 8

We're not sure what crawled up and died inside the Red Raiders basketball team this season, but it's been bad. How bad? Bad enough that if the campus were in New Orleans instead of Lubbock, the locals would already have staged a full-blown street funeral. Folks, we're talking about a Texas Tech team that won 27 games last year and reached the Sweet 16 before bowing out. The current squad, though, is trapped in the hell of an 0-8 SU and 1-7 ATS meltdown, destroying a strong 10-2 start. Searching for a point of origin, we thought perhaps the Red Raiders' bad luck started when 6-11 Center Fardaws Aimaq, their top transfer, injured his foot. But he returned against Texas four games ago, and Tech lost all four. The pièce de résistance, however, came in last Wednesday's 15-point blowout loss at home against West Virginia, which caused many a talking head to declare that Texas Tech had officially hit rock bottom. And while they currently reside in the Big 12 cellar, we don't think they'll stay there for long. Not with Iowa State coming to town. The Red Raiders are still red-faced thinking about the last time these two met in Ames three weeks ago, where the Cyclones annihilated them, 80-54 – Texas Tech's worst loss this season, and its worst overall since 2015. The Raiders had gone **7-1 SU and 8-0 ATS** in the series with ISU before the blowout, and just so happen to own a **7-1 ATS** at home with revenge versus the Cyclones. Iowa State also has a revenge affair with Kansas on deck, and the Clones are just 3-22 SU away before facing the Jayhawks, including 6-10-1 ATS the last 17 games. Tech makes up for a season's worth of hurt by bringing down the Cyclones.

5★ BEST BET

KANSAS over Kansas State by 17

Woe be unto the Jayhawks. We don't know how they fared in Saturday's road trip to Kentucky, but ol' Uncle Mo was clearly on the side of the UK Wildcats in that contest: suddenly unbeatable Kentucky had crushed four straight quality opponents while the high-flying 'Hawks had seen a 16-1 start go south with a trio of agonizing defeats. So, if KU didn't bring down Calipari's Cats, the woe factor will have grown exponentially by the time this one rolls around. Going back several weeks ago when Kansas appeared invincible, who would have believed they'd be hosting rival Kansas State with same-season revenge? Not only that, but Bill Self's boys are also looking up at the Manhattan Cats in the Big 12 standings. What's that saying about it being darkest before the dawn? The fact is Kansas stands only one game out of first place and we expect a strong surge down the stretch. It starts here with KU bringing a **3-0 SUATS** mark in this contest in games in which they own the inferior record by an average win margin of 20 PPG. As for the over-achieving Wildcats, they're just **1-5 ATS** against foes they beat earlier in the season by one-point exact. And if that's not bad enough, they crawl into this week's **INCREDIBLE STAT** box with a gaudy **7-40 ATS** mark in conference games they fail to win against avenging opponents. Let's face it: Kansas is a ticking time bomb right now and we expect them to hit the 0:00 mark against hated Kansas State tonight. One last ka-boom from **THE CLINCHER: Kansas is 4-0 SUATS since 1990 when seeking same-season revenge against Kansas State, with every win by a double-digit margin.**

MISSOURI over Lsu by 14

With Alabama, Tennessee, and Texas A&M – and recently Kentucky – getting most of the attention in this year's SEC coverage, you may not have had an opportunity to check out who we think is one of the conference's real sleepers: Missouri. Sporting a 15-5 record at press time, Mizzou found itself sitting at No. 56 overall in the KenPom.com rankings heading into the weekend, whereas the visiting Bengals have slipped all the way down to No. 123 in the same rankings. Yes, LSU's 12-1 start to the season came to a grinding halt with seven straight losses for the Bengal Cats, and as a result they find themselves in a 3-way mess with both of the Mississippi's at the bottom of the SEC totem pole. They also have to face off against a Missouri team tonight that remembers its season-ending loss to LSU in the Donkey Round of last year's SEC tourney, and that sets the table here as they check in with a sparkling **3-0 SUATS** log in home games when seeking LTKO revenge. The Tigers from COMO have lost just two games in Mizzou Arena this season, against Kansas and Alabama – two squads that are head-and-shoulders above the troubled Tigers from the bayou. With only one conference win in his pocket this season, we don't see anything changing soon for first-year LSU head coach Matt McMahon. Lay it if you play it.


Friday, February 3

SAN DIEGO STATE over Boise State by 11

It's time to show a little West Coast love to our readers with what should be a humdinger of a clash. At press time, the Aztecs were leading the Mountain West race by one game over Nevada and Boise State, so this meeting has huge implications. It's also got some big-time revenge backing the home team. The 23-win Aztecs took last year's 53-52 loss in the finals of last season's MWC championship hard as they proceeded to go one-and-out in the Big Dance when they fell as opening round favorites. They're back to get even tonight knowing they are 8-5 SU and 9-3 ATS in this series, as well as 6-1 SU and 4-2-1 ATS at home when seeking LTKO revenge. Like SDSU, the Broncos also lost in the first round of the NCAA tourney last season and returned with plenty of experience this season. However, a wobbly 35-59-1 ATS mark in outright conference losses as a dog reaffirms our position. With 4 starters back from last year's celebrated squad, and Boise State having beaten them like a drum in three meetings last season, we expect the Aztecs' best effort tonight.

3★ BEST BET

SAN ANTONIO over Phoenix by 10

Here we go, hopping on Coach Pop's back in another Silver Spur situation. It occurred when the Suns handed San Antonio its worst conference home loss in the Greg Popovich era in a 133-95 defeat here in their last meeting in early December. The Well-Oiled Machine jumps right into the fray noting the Spurs are **6-1-1 ATS** with same-season revenge from a loss of 20-plus points in this series. That fits like a glove next to the Suns' spotty **2-8-2 ATS** record when facing foes they beat by more than 36 points earlier in the season. A quick check of each team's body of work this season shows Phoenix flattening out on a 10-19 run at press time, after beginning the season 15-6. On the flip side, San Antonio put a halt to a 6-18 SU and 9-15 ATS beginning to this campaign as they've improved since, going 8-16 SU and 15-10 ATS. All of which leads us to **THE CLINCHER: San Antonio is 5-0 ATS with revenge from a same-season defeat of more than 30 points under Greg Popovich when coming off a win or a loss of 5 or fewer points in its last game.**

Sunday, January 29

CLEVELAND over LA Clippers 14

This is automatic in our NBA book of handicapping with Cleveland looking to avenge an earlier season loss at Los Angeles where they fell 119-117 as small road chalk. The game sets to the max as the paper Clips enter off a same-season avenger of their own at Atlanta last night and given the fact that they are 5-15 SU and 6-14 ATS in games on the North coast, including **0-4 ATS** when the Cavs are looking to settle up from an earlier season loss of fewer than 20 points in this series. With Los Angeles just 4-9-1 ATS in non-conference clashes on Sundays, and Cleveland 9-2 ATS on the first day of the week, look for a Cavs' assault this evening.

Tuesday, January 31

4★ BEST BET

Miami over CLEVELAND by 7

The young guns from Cleveland host a team that has been a thorn in their side, only tonight they'll be laying points to the angry visitors from Miami. It's a sketchy setting for the Cavs who hosted the Clippers here on Sunday knowing they are just **3-13 SUATS** in games after facing the Clips, including **0-5 SU** and **0-4-1 ATS** in the last five such occurrences. The Heat take the floor sporting a 12-5 SUATS mark in this series, including 4-1 ATS when looking to avenge a same-season defeat (they lost 113-87 here in their last matchup in November). One thing for certain, though, is points figure to be at a premium in this matchup of the Association's two top-ranked teams in scoring defense. With Cleveland staring dead ahead to another same-season rematch with Memphis, we're flip-flopping on our call with them on Sunday as we hand it over to **THE CLINCHER: Miami is 7-4 SU and 8-3 ATS as a road dog from Game 28 out with Eric Spoelstra when seeking revenge from a same-season loss of 25 or more points, including 6-1 ATS against winning foes.**

LA Lakers over INDIANA by 6

It's Groundhog Day, and with it, Bill Murray's favorite NBA team will be looking to even the scorecard against the Pacers from a one-point nip job suffered earlier this season in La La Land. They'll bring a solid 15-8 SUATS record along with them in contests when seeking same-season revenge in this series. They are also a dependable 12-8 ATS in non-conference contests this season at press time, including **5-0 ATS** in their previous five games. Meanwhile, the Pacers have hit an icy patch at press time where they have lost 8 of their previous 9 games, managing to cash the money only two times. Shadow or not today, with Indiana off a same-season revenger with Memphis, and just 4-11 SU and 3-13 ATS in post-Grizzly gatherings, spring is around the corner and the Lakers are on our playlist tonight.

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5★ BEST BET

Orlando over MINNESOTA by 10

You can rest assured if there is one Eastern Conference foe the Timberwolves would rather not face these days it would be the Magic. That's the same Disney crew that has lit it up of late, going 14-10 SU and 18-6 ATS at press time after opening the season a listless 5-19 SU and 10-2-2 ATS. With it, they've played themselves into the Eastern Conference playoff race, just three games back from qualifying at press time. On the other side of the court, Minnesota enters after looking to avenge a same season-defeat to Golden State (5-10 SUATS post Warrior workouts) with yet another same-season avenger on tap with Denver. After checking off all the boxes, it's time to turn things over to **THE CLINCHER: Orlando is 20-8 SUATS in this series, including 8-0 ATS when seeking same-season revenge.**
