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

4★ BEST BET

GEORGIA over Missouri by 10

It's a no-brainer that Mizzou's basketball team will be singing along to 'Georgia On My Mind' as they ride the bus to Stegeman Coliseum in Athens. After all, the Tigers come a-calling on the heels of picking up their 20th win of the season in a 66-64 overtime revenge squeaker at home against Mississippi State – while the battered Bulldogs limp in off red-faced losses of 32 and 49 points in their last two contests. Even so, Georgia takes the floor with a 16-10 effort this season, good enough to keep them clinging to the NCAA Tournament bubble. That's a far cry from last year's 6-26 embarrassment (1-17 in SEC play) that sent head coach Tom Crean to the showers and led to the hiring of former Florida head coach Mike White. White has some decent ATS history to lean on today: the Dawgs are **3-0 ATS** home as a dog or a favorite of fewer than 3 points in this series, **3-0 SUATS** as a conference home dog when coming off a loss of 30-plus points, and **5-1 ATS** as conference home dogs over the past 12 months. Meanwhile, Missouri stands just 2-4 SUATS in games after battling MSU and the Tigers have struggled to cash tickets of late, going just **1-5 ATS** in their six most recent outings. In this battle of cats and dogs, we'll back the Dawgs with added support coming via **THE CLINCHER**: See this week's **AWESOME ANGLE** on page 2.

OKLAHOMA ST over Kansas St by 12

A month ago, the Cowboys were riding a 5-game win streak and a 16-9 record. Bubble? What bubble? Then came losses to Kansas, TCU and West Virginia, and suddenly 16-12 Oklahoma State is in danger of sliding off the dreaded NCAA Tournament bubble completely. But while they return home off three straight double-digit losses, the Pokes do own a 7-2 SUATS ledger at Gallagher-Iba Arena when playing off three losses exact. They're also **4-0 SUATS** at home off a loss this season, and **3-0 ATS** home in this series when seeking revenge from a same-season defeat of 6-plus points. Kansas State, easily the surprise team in what has been a Big 12 meat-grinder of a campaign, may have 21 wins in the bank but the Wildcats aren't exactly a fine-tuned machine of late, losing 4 of their last seven games. Even worse for first-year KSU head coach Jerome Tang, his squad's home-road dichotomy sticks out like a sore thumb: 13-1 SU and 10-4 ATS at Manhattan as opposed to 3-6 SU and 4-5 ATS away. Toss in a triple revenger on deck with Oklahoma for the Purple Cats, and Kansas State looks to be in over its head here in Stillwater. You know what to do.

SAN JOSE ST over Boise St by 7

Yet another struggling program looking to right the ship, 16-12 San Jose State has almost played its way off the infamous NCAA

bubble. First came a humbling 96-68 home loss to New Mexico, the Spartans' biggest margin of defeat since losing to Arkansas by 41 points back in early December. That was followed by SJSU's 66-51 defeat at Nevada on Tuesday, where Tim Miles' team scored its second-fewest points in a game this season. However, don't forget the Spartans have come a mighty long way since finishing 8-23 in Miles' first season last year, and they appear to be in an ideal spot for an upset here. For openers, Boise State is currently breathing down the neck of MWC leader San Diego State, just one game back at press time. Then there's the ugly fact that it's been almost a month since BSU cashed a ticket, going **6-1 SU but only 1-6 ATS**. That brings the Well Oiled Machine to life, and the **WOM** informs us that conference road favorites on a 5-game ATS losing skid like Boise are just 7-13 ATS against winning opposition, including 3-10 SUATS when favored by 4 or fewer points (check the spread). And not only are the Spartans **3-0 ATS** the last three games in this series, and **3-0 SUATS** at home when coming off a previous home loss, they've logged a competitive 10-3 SU and 8-4 ATS home record at The Event Center this season. With the Broncos taking the court off a same-season revenge win against New Mexico and sporting just a 3-7 ATS effort against avenging foes in post-Lobo competitions, west coast Sparty gets the call.

INDIANA ST over Missouri St by 17

The words "Second Coming" mean different things to different people, but for those who live in Terre Haute, Indiana, it means this: When will we get another Larry Bird? When the Hick from French Lick played for Indiana State in the late 1970's, the Sycamores compiled a record of 81-13 and actually entered the 78-79 NCAA Championship game against Michigan State with a perfect 33-0 mark. Once Bird flew the coop, however, the next 11 years saw the Sycamores go 110-197, and they've managed only five 20-win campaigns in the 44 seasons following Larry's departure. Well, one of those 20-gamers was recorded this year, with sophomore head coach Josh Schertz rebounding from his 11-20 debut last season to a 20-10 ledger that could find ISU securing an invitation to the Big Dance – if the winning continues. Why not? Currently in a three-way tie for 3rd place in the MVC, the 5-returning starter Sycamores have been on a scorching **7-1 SU and 8-0 ATS** skien with the only loss coming by a single point at Belmont, 89-88. We expect them to return to their winning ways here, especially since they were nipped by Missouri State, 64-62, in Springfield in mid-January. In the 11 games since beating the Sycamores, the Bears are a money-burning 2-8-1 ATS. Yes, they arrive off a off same-season revenge victory over Murray State, but they're just 1-3 ATS after running with the Racers. The final coffin nail for Missouri State is its **0-5 ATS** failure in the last five games when coming off a win, which is hammered home by **THE CLINCHER: Indiana State is 6-1 SU and 5-1-1 ATS in Last Home Games of the season, including 4-0-1 ATS when playing with revenge.**

OKLAHOMA ST over Baylor by 11

Saddle up, folks, because we're riding with the Cowboys at home again tonight, as they gear up for 16-point same-season loss revenge, courtesy of a 74-58 beat down six weeks ago at Baylor. The Bears had dropped two straight games to Kansas and Kansas State prior to a same-season revenger against Texas at Waco over the weekend, and they're just 4-20 SU and 8-16 ATS after the Longhorns, including **3-14 ATS** when coming off a loss (check Saturday result). That doesn't bode well considering the Pokes are **6-0-1 ATS** in this series with same-season revenge from a loss of 7 or more points when Baylor takes the floor with a greater



than .666 win percentage. Oklahoma State also performs well in Last Home Games, going 21-7 SU and 18-10 ATS the last this role, including **3-0 SUATS** with same-season revenge of 15-plus points. Home teams in the Big 12 have flexed their muscles this campaign, going 123-28 SU overall and 50-25 SU in conference clashes. Those stats look especially good when the visiting Bears bring a woeful 5-22 ATS record when coming off a home game and facing foes in LHGs. We'll leave Baylor alone until next Saturday's home and regular season finale against Iowa State.

5★ BEST BET

NEW MEXICO over Fresno St by 20

After struggling to a 13-19 mark last year in head coach Richard Pitino's first season in Albuquerque, the Lobos head down the regular season stretch with a solid 20-8 record. In fact, tonight's teams are going in opposite directions with 20-win New Mexico playing its Last Home Game looking to avenge a same-season loss against the visiting 10-win Bulldogs. Meanwhile, Fresno State is just playing for position in the MWC's upcoming conference tournament, and the dogs enter after meeting with Nevada, sporting a **0-6-1 ATS** ledger in games after same-season revengers with the Wolf Pack. Last Home Games have been kind to New Mexico backers of late, as the Lobos are **5-0 ATS** if .800 or less and looking to avenge a same-season loss of fewer than 7 points. And when the 'R' word is in play for UNM, they're **3-0 ATS** with same-season revenge of 3 or more points in this series when Fresno State owns a sub .630 win percentage. All things considered, this looks like a bad time for the Bulldogs to be entering The Pit... which is a good segue to **THE CLINCHER: Fresno State resides inside this week's INCREDIBLE STAT on page 2.**

(1) HORIZON LEAGUE

THE WAY WE SEE IT: As has become the norm in the League, the only team from the Horizon appearing in this year's Dance will be the one cutting down the nets on March 7. Last year it was Wright State, who nipped Northern Kentucky by 1 point in the title game. It marked the 14th time in the past 15 tourneys in which the No. 1 seed failed to climb the ladder. Thus, it's an ominous spot in which **YOUNGSTOWN STATE** finds itself this year. Making matters worse for the Penguins, they bring a 0-4 SUATS mark into this event when coming off consecutive wins... **CLEVELAND STATE** captured the crown two seasons ago yet fell to the eventual champion Raiders in the second-round as a No. 1 seed last season. Despite a 3-11-1 ATS dog log in this event, the Vikings have won seven of their last ten games in this tourney and should be considered dangerous... **NORTHERN KENTUCKY** fell by the narrowest of margins in the title game of this tournament last season and stand 3-0 SUATS as single-digit dogs in this competition. They were 14-6 against sub

.600 opponents this season but only 3-6 versus better... Defending champion **WRIGHT STATE** gains the 4th nod as they've made it to the finals in 6 of the last 10 years in this event, and stands 21-14 SU and 21-13-1 ATS overall in this tourney, including 17-7 SU and 16-7-1 ATS when laying points.

THE SLEEPER: PURDUE-FORT WAYNE

The Mastodons were in this spot last season and they've earned a return ticket. And for the second straight year IUPFW returned 4 starters, this time from last year's 21-win squad. They were the preseason No. 2 choice in the loop this campaign and underachieved this season. A wake-up call could be in order.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET:

PLAY ON DONKEY ROUND FAVS OF 10 OR FEWER POINTS

As our TECH NOTES call out above, manageable favorites in the Donkey Round of this event have rewarded backers handsomely. FYI: They also improve to 14-2-2 ATS when facing foes off a loss.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: For the third year in a row the Pensacola Bay Center will welcome the fun-in-the-sun guys where the winner of this tournament will once again likely be another one-and-done in the Big Dance. What's really weird is last year's titleist, Georgia State, lost all five of its starters and is this year's trash collector with the Panthers looking up the conference standings at every member. Heading this year's list of wannabes is **MARSHALL**, one of four newcomers in the Sun Belt this season. They won only a dozen games last season but, behind returning 4 starters, were projected to finish in sixth place in the Sun Belt. The problem is they've won only one conference tourney, the CUSA in 2018, over the past 16 seasons so this will be new territory for the Herd in more ways than one... **SOUTHERN MISS** is also a surprise newcomer to the conference this season after winning only 7 games in the CUSA last year. They are at their best as a favorite in the CUSA tournament, going 12-3 SU and 10-5 ATS, including 11-0 SU and 9-2 ATS against avenging foes... **UL LAFAYETTE** welcomed 4 starters back from last year's 16-win unit and it vaulted them to a 20-plus win effort. It's one reason they were the preseason favorite to win the Sun Belt after

finishing as the runner-up in this event last season... **TROY** enters the fray as another 20-win unit, and the Trojans stand 8-4 SUATS the last dozen games in this event, including 8-2 SUATS versus sub .666 foes. They were also 15-5 outright against non-winning opponents this season.

THE SLEEPER: SOUTH ALABAMA

The Jaguars were an ATM machine this season, especially down the stretch when they won and covered 7 of eight games at press time. A 21-win team last season who started slow this campaign, they were the No. 2 choice in the Sun Belt in the preseason and are playing like that entering this competition.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET:

PLAY AGAINST TEAMS OFF A SU UNDERDOG WIN

As we called out on this page last year, Sun Belters tend to party a little too hard in games following an upset win in this tourney. That's confirmed by the fact that they are just 3-16 SU and 5-14 ATS in follow-up games, including 1-12 SU and 2-11 ATS since 2015.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: This used to be the haunt for Sister Jean when she was busy blessing Loyola Chicago at this time of the year in the Big Dance. After capturing this event last season, they've both rambled on to the Atlantic 10 as the Valley took on a new complexion this season. With it, the conference managed to produce no less than five 20-win teams, any of which are capable of claiming this year's title. Our outside choice to do that is **INDIANA STATE**, a team that win only 11 games last season but returned all 5 starters, each of whom made a major impact this season. While they've been a big-time bust in this tournament (2-9 SUATS last 11 games), they are 9-3 outright as favorites in games in which they were not outmatched. The Sycamores took a 9-game ATS win streak into their final contest of the season at press time... **DRAKE** is the chic choice to grab this year's crown, and justifiably so. Like LSU, they closed like a freight train winning 13 of their final 14 games at press time. A 10-3 SUATS mark as chalk in this tourney also works in their favor... **BRADLEY** is yet another 'hot hand' entering this tourney, riding a 7-0 SUATS win skein into its final game of the season. To top it off, the Braves own 6 wins in their

last eight games in this event... **BELMONT** is another newcomer to the Valley this season as they joined Ohio Valley Conference power Murray State moving into the conference this season. While the Racers were disappointing, the 20-win Bruins have delivered the goods. Behind a savvy head coach in Casey Alexander, consider them dangerous.

THE SLEEPER: SOUTHERN ILLINOIS

The Salukis are drenched with experience in this tourney with seven title game appearances. They are also 17-5 outright against sub .500 opposition in this event, which figures to put them into position to make a strong push. They were also 18-3 SU against sub .650 foes heading into the season final against Illinois Chicago.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET:

PLAY ON THE NO. 1 SEED IN THEIR FIRST GAME

As we've said many times on this page in the past, the numbers don't lie. No. 1 seeds in this tourney are a jaw-dropping 32-1 SU and 23-9-1 ATS in opening round games after Northern Iowa knocked off Illinois State 78-65 last year. You know the deal.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: For the eighth time in the last nine years, the first two teams slotted into our Final Four teams are the same. And why not? These same two teams sit at the top of the WCC this season while having knocked heads in the championship game each of the last four years, and six of the last seven. Until knocked off their throne, **GONZAGA** gains the top nod again this season. The Bulldogs have won this tourney 17 of the last 20 years, while arriving to the title game all twenty-one seasons. With it, the Zags are 49-5 SU and 32-21-1 ATS in this event, including 34-0 SU against No. 3 or worse opponents. After earning the coveted No. 1 seed in the Big Dance six of the last seven years, it won't happen this season – but cutting down the nets here is quite likely. One note of interest: the G-Men were the No. 2 overall preseason team in the nation this season. Forewarned is forearmed... Ken Pom has **SAINT MARY'S** ranked higher (8) than the Zags this season (No. 13). While it was clear sailing most of the campaign, the Gaels did struggle in their seven games (2-5 ATS) leading up to their season finale with the Bulldogs... **SANTA CLARA** Like last year, the Broncos are peaking at the right time, taking a 6-game win streak into their season finale at San

Diego. They're 11-5 ATS in their last sixteen games in this tourney, as well as 8-0 ATS when coming off consecutive SUATS wins in this competition... The biggest hurdle facing **BYU** is their 5-15-2 ATS all-time record in this tournament, including 1-10-2 ATS when coming off a win of 8 or more points. Still, they were 8-2 ATS as underdogs this season and that could fit like a glove in this year's tourney.

THE SLEEPER: LOYOLA MARYMOUNT

The Lions roared as underdogs this season when they took a 9-5-1 ATS dog log record into their final game of the season, including 5-0 SUATS as dogs of 4 or fewer points. They are also 12-5-2 ATS in this tournament the past ten seasons, and 4-0 ATS versus No. 1 or No. 2 seeds in this event. Play accordingly.

KEY TOURNAMENT BEST BET:

PLAY ON ANY FAVORITE WITH SAME SEASON REVENGE

Safe to say this tourney has been a chalk lovers' haven, with favorites going 100-73-5 ATS overall, including 83-47-5 ATS when favored by fewer than 12 points. However, when any of these favorites is looking to avenge a same-season loss, they zoom to 13-1 SUATS.

THE WAY WE SEE IT: The Colonial expanded to 13 teams this season with our top two choices in this year's tourney the clear-cut favorites to climb the ladder. **CHARLESTON** was the crème de la crème in the loop this season, taking a staggering 27-3 record into its season finale against Stony Brook. The Cougars are 6-2 SU and 5-2-1 ATS in this tournament with a .700 or greater win percentage, as well as 7-1 outright against foes with an inferior record... **HOFSTRA** closed like a runaway train, winning each of its last 10 games prior to its season finale against Northeastern. The Pride took a 14-3 ATS conference mark into its season ender as well. They've also enjoyed an uptick in this tourney, going 4-2 SUATS the past three seasons after a troubling 0-6 ATS prior run... A 25-win team with 4 starters back this season, **TOWSON** was the preseason choice to win the Colonial this year. An unexpected 5-game losing streak in December slowed their chances. They were 16-5 SU against losing foes but only 3-7 SU and 4-6 against winners. Another massive hurdle is the Tigers' tiny 2-9 SU and 1-10 ATS mark

in their last eleven games in this event... Despite a 1-3 start to the year, **NC WILMINGTON** enjoyed another 20-win season. The Seagulls lost in the finals last season and figure to be anxious to make amends.

THE SLEEPER: DELAWARE

After winning the event last season as a No. 5 seed, the Blue Hens were the 3rd choice in the preseason conference polls this year. Momentum over the course of a short period of time can work wonders in conference tourneys. CAA teams in this role are 14-2-2 ATS since 1990, including 11-0 ATS when they sport a win percentage of more than .333.

Miles, 21 was arrested for his alleged involvement in a shooting that killed a 23-year-old woman last month, and a law enforcement officer testified that Miles texted star forward Miller to bring Miles' gun to the scene where the shooting happened. This unfortunate situation was certainly weighing on the Tide players' minds a week ago at South Carolina after the s**t first hit the fan. In fact, Bama was so discombobulated that they needed a horrific call in the late, late stages of overtime from the zebras to avoid an OT loss as 17-point chalk over the Gamecocks. As if the Miles & Miller soap opera wasn't distracting enough, the Crimson Tide enters just 5-6 SU and 3-8 ATS in LHGs, including **1-7 ATS** when they sport a .575 or great win percentage, and 3-5 SU and **1-6-1 ATS** in this series in games in which Auburn owns a .700 or fewer win percentage. Right on cue, Aubbie enters 10-2 ATS as a dog of more than 10 points in this series, including **8-0 ATS** when the Tide is coming off a win (check Saturday home result against Arkansas), which fits like a glove next to the Tigers' **8-2 ATS** ledger as dogs of the same caliber in SEC contests versus greater than .750 foes. Heading into Saturday's scrape at Kentucky, the Tigers were in need of one more win over the course of their final three games of the season to join the 20-win club. With Alabama head coach Nate Oats and his players sweating bullets over Miles' case going to a grand jury, let's call on War Eagle to spring the upset.

Michigan over ILLINOIS by 1

Once again, the NCAA Tournament bubble rears its ugly head. These two teams were locked in a 4-way tie for third place in the Big Ten race with Indiana and Maryland at press time, but Michigan owned a 16-12 record overall, not 19-9 like the three other teams mentioned. Thus, Juan Howard's Wolverine hoopsters are in need of every win they can muster if they wish to impress the selection committee. Fortunately for Howard, his team has responded with a 5-2 SUATS February compared to a middling 3-3 SUATS effort from the Illini. The Wolverines are **6-1-1 ATS** with revenge in this series (Illini took them down twice last season) when Illinois enters with a sub .700 win percentage, and the **WOM** reminds us the Wolves are 8-4 ATS as a dog during the regular season following a LHG, including 5-2 SU and **6-1 ATS** when facing sub .750 foes.
