So how nice of a job has rookie replacement QB Brock Purdy done for the 49ers? Consider: He is the first rookie quarterback to win his first five starts since 2004 (Ben Roethlisberger). Purdy also has multiple TD passes in his last six games. But perhaps the biggest testament to his success is the fact that San Francisco was 2-30 outright in games when trailing by 3 or more points entering the fourth quarter when Purdy rallied them past the Raiders in this role on New Year's Day. And for that we say "CONGRATULATIONS", which also is the title of a

Playbook BLACK BOOK article that reminds us that home teams in their initial NFL playoff game who lost at home in a conference championship game last season are **27-2 SU** and **21-7-1 ATS** in Game One in these contests if they won a dozen of more games last season. The Seahawks enter as one of seven playoff teams this year that missed the postseason in 2021. However, the **WOM** (Well-Oiled Machine) alerts us to the fact that double-digit dogs in the Wild Card round with same-season revenge are just **1-5 ATS** – which makes for only one way to look here.

This matchup features two young, promising quarterbacks in Justin Herbert and Trevor Lawrence, each of whom has become the face of their franchise. Herbert is the only QB, other than Peyton Manning, with three 25 TD seasons in his first three years in the league. But then there is bonehead adversarial head coach Brandon Staley, who appears to love going against the grain simply for the sake of going against the grain, a move that cost him dearly when he left his starters in late into last week's meaningless game, only to lose star WR Mike Williams to a back injury in the second half.

That's a heavy load for a team that was just 1-5 in games against fellow playoff squads this season (the worst of all teams). Enter the AFC South champion Jaguars, the first team since the 2008 Dolphins to win a division the season after having the league's worst record which, behind head coach Doug Pederson, places them inside our **INCREDIBLE STAT** on page 2. And per the **SMART BOX**, Pederson also shines in the postseason, going 4-2 SU and 5-1 ATS, including **5-0 ATS** as a playoff dog. Coupled with the fact that Wild Card home pick or dogs are 12-3 ATS, look for the Bolts to short-circuit here.

Oh, if only the Cincinnati Bengals knew what the league came to know about QB Justin Herbert, they surely would have drafted him with the first pick in the 2020 NFL Draft – and Joe Burrow would likely have been selected with the No. 5 choice by Miami. Instead, the Dolphins will take the field today behind Teddy Bridgewater or Skylar Thompson knowing their last playoff win was 20 years ago. The Fish have gone 0-4 SUATS in postseason games since and are **1-8 SU** and **2-7 ATS** on the playoff road by an average loss margin of 22 PPG. We certainly

don't want any of that, not in frigid Buffalo as the Dolphins are **1-11 SU** and **3-9 ATS** away in outside stadiums in January since 1990, as well as **2-14 SU** and **3-13 ATS** in Buffalo when arriving off a SUATS home win. You can rest assured the Bills will play the Damar Hamlin card throughout the postseason. In addition, Buffalo is the only team in the playoffs that out-yarded each of the other playoff teams they faced this season. With Bills Mafia backers 31-9-4 ATS in games Buffalo wins outright as a favorite behind Josh Allen, you either lay it or get out of the way.
