## ANALYSIS

It is very difficult to win this race going wire-to-wire and the last horse that did so was Stonetastic 8 years ago. Most editions have been won by closers as the pace setup is typically one made up of heavy, energy-depleting pace pressure. This year's edition will be no exception as the pace models are showing 6 fillies/mares lining up within 2 lengths of one another on the front end. The race couldn't set up any better for last year's winner of the race, **#9 Maryquitecontrary** who will be benefited by a very comparable pace set up. She'll be just 5 lengths back in the early going with just 3 lengths to make up on the pace leaders as she approaches the top of the stretch. She owns a perfect 9 for 9 Exacta record over this surface and is 7 for 8 going 7 furlongs. Her remarkable consistency can be attributed to her trainer, Edward Plesa, Jr., figuring out early on that 7 furlongs and 1-turn miles are her wheelhouse distances. In addition, she owns a big turn of foot for a horse that has run exclusively on dirt. The clear top pick in this race. **#8 Gerrymander**, out of the Chad Brown barn takes a big drop into a field so much easier than anything she has faced over her last 6 starts. She has won going 1 turn miles but cuts back here to 7 furlongs which isn't ideal but given the drop into so much easier it becomes less of a concern. In addition, she'll be present the pace here and it will be more than manageable for her leaving plenty in the tank for that stretch drive. She'll get first jump on the Top Win pick, **#9 Maryquitecontrary** but will be all in to hold that one off approaching the wire. According to the Super Screener, it comes down to those two horses. The challenging pace set up is very favorable to the Super Screener Top Long Shot pick, **#2 Two Item Saver**. The lightly raced filly will be reserved in the early going making up the back marker. She'll still have plenty of work to do as she hits the stretch but she'll be passing a lot of other horses on the way to the wire...it is only a matter of how many.

## ANALYSIS

This is an very enticing horizontal and vertical wagering opportunity as the Super Screener scoring is very convicted on two horses in particular for the win spot. It is another overflow field featuring fillies and mares that will travel 8.5 furlongs on the turf course. With this full field we'll have a pretty hot pace setup and there will be pace pressure as 3 fillies/mares line up on the front end to determine pace supremacy and it will include **#6 Ruby Nell**, **#8 Queen Goddess** and **#10 Sister Lou Ann**. The Super Screener Top Win pick honors goes to the very lightly raced 5-yr-old mare, **#4 Star Fortress** who is coming off that blow-away victory last out going 9 furlongs. After plying her trade across England for 7 of her 8 career starts she made a statement in her US debut submitting a superior running line that got stronger as the race progressed. It was her first start off a 4-month layoff making the performance that much more progressive. She cuts back in distance which isn't necessarily a positive but what offsets that disadvantage some is her strong turn of foot and ability to track relatively close to this fast pace without being compromised by it. Look for a follow up effort here that will be just as strong as her last. **#9 Didia** is the most reliable board hitter in the race thanks to her balance and solid late foot. She has won races anywhere from 8.5 to 10 furlongs and delivers the sharpest turn of foot at shorter route distances. She was in way over her head in the salty Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf but prior to that she won 8 of her 9 races. She will sit a great trip just 4 lengths off the pace and that early speed is going to be coming back to her in a hurry. This is a very reliable single to use up down vertical wagers. Her Super Screener Energy Reserve Index is best in the field. If we can get long odds on the Motion Graham-trained filly, **#11 Mission of Joy**, she's the Super Screener Top Long Shot pick. She's coming off a long break but has successfully responded well off similar layoffs. Her 3rd place finish against Mawj and Lindy in that G1 QEII Cup at Keeneland was quite memorable as she tracked the fast pace and kept on to finish a very game 3rd. Her works leading up to this have been long and strong giving every indication she is sitting on a big performance. She has not missed the Superfecta in 7 starts on turf going 8 to 9 furlongs and she won't miss it here at a solid price.

## ANALYSIS

It is another full capacity field that is lining up for this year’s renewal of the G3 Fred W. Hooper Stakes. Not only will the pace be swift but it will be highly pressured with as many a 6 or 7 horses all forward running within two lengths of one another through demanding fractions. This sets up very well for a horse that will be coming from off the pace. Rising to the top of Super Screener scoring is **#12 Signator**, trained by Shug McGaughey and ridden by regular rider, Javier Castellano. This horse is in the midst of a dream form cycle progression and, as a lightly raced 4-yr-old making his 2nd start off the layoff, Form Cycle Analysis is revealing a healthy 4 to 5-point move forward aided in part by that cut back to a one-turn mile which is a configuration that has resulted in prior success. He has moved forward in each of his last three starts including the pairing of triple-digit BRIS Late Pace figures in his last two starts which makes him dangerous even under slower pace scenarios. In this race, he gets plenty of pace and pace pressure to close into. He’ll have 6 to 7 lengths to make up on the pace leaders as he comes out of the final turn so he’ll need every bit of that turn of foot and a pace erosion to get by them all. However, he owns all the pace advantage here and will leverage it fully. The far outside draw is not a concern here at all as that long run from the shoot to the first turn it is actually an advantage. This Top Win and Top Board Hitter pick comes with plenty of value. A very strong win contender. **#11 Tumbarumba** is a very interesting win prospect. This 4-yr-old gelding out of the very productive Brian Lynch barn is in peak form right now. Toss that one flop in the slop back in July and he sports a very desirable, extended form progression pattern. After a huge top posted two races back he was wisely rested to provide plenty of time to recover of that demanding effort. In his last start he tracked an insanely fast pace (track variant adjusted) submitting an impossible pace top but still managed to finish 2nd going a furlong longer than he will navigate here. That was a sneaky good performance and coming off that pace top, Form Cycle Analysis is calling for a 3-point move forward on his way to a new top. He’ll be closer to the pace than the other two win contenders but not too close to the heat though, after that last start, he’ll find this pace to be much, much easier despite it clocking in faster than par. He is working up a storm leading into this so all systems go. **#3 Steal Sunshine** is always around the money and he is a bit of a horse for course finishing in the Superfecta 10 times in 13 starts over this surface. He is also 4 for 7 going the mile distance. He has been managed well with plenty of time between races as of late which resulted in a string of 3 straight improvements from July to October. He figures to begin a new forward progression cycle in this second start off the layoff with a 2 to 4-point move forward being predicted. He’ll save ground throughout and will have just 3 lengths to make up on tiring leaders as he turns for home. He owns that desired balanced Energy Distribution Profile which is why at these route distances he so regularly hits the board. Meets easier than he did in his last race and this contest sets up so well for him. Another player offering a favorable risk/reward value proposition.

## ANALYSIS

Leading into the Pegasus Wold Cup is this great wagering affair featuring an overflow field of 12 that will traverse the 9 furlongs over a turf course with plenty of run up to that first turn. The pace will land right around par with plenty of pressure and a likely duel between pace leaders **#1 Atone** and **#11 Main Event**. That pair will clear off by two lengths over 6 horses that will be bunched up as the primary stalkers. Trailing the field by 10 lengths will be the deepest closer **#8 Master Piece**. The Super Screener landed on **#5 Webslinger** as the Top Win, Top Board Hitter and Top Value pick in the race. His last 3 races were much better than they look on paper as his Super Screener Energy Reserve Index is coming back off the charts as it relates this pace set up and race configuration. No other horse rates higher for late-race stamina than this 4-yr-old gelding. He'll have about 7 lengths to make up on the pace leaders as he comes out of the final turn but a lot of that pressured speed will be coming back to him in a hurry. This will be just his 3rd race since August so he comes into this plenty fresh which is why Form Cycle Analysis is projecting a new lifetime top in this contest. Note that he is 8 for 8 in the Trifecta over his last 9 starts when running less than 10 furlongs and he is 2 for 2 in the Exacta over this turf course. The risk reward value proposition is highly favorable. **#3 Integration** is the likely favorite in this race and deservedly so off his undefeated record over 3 career starts. He has easily put away each field he as faced with his last start being his best in the G2 Hill Prince in which he showed that desired balanced Energy Distribution Profile doling out 90+ BRIS Pace/Speed Rating figures throughout. He'll be well positioned in this race playing a stalker role just 3 lengths off the lead and will get first jump on deeper closers. He is working like he is sitting on a big race. The lone filly in the race, is certainly a special and well traveled one as the multiple Group 1 winner out of the Aiden O'Brien barn comes back stateside after a good showing the Group 1 Hong Kong Vase Stakes after shipping cross country to loose by a narrowing neck to the sensational Inspiral in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. However, the big question on this filly is whether or not 9 furlongs is just too tight for her as she is clearly at her best going 10 to 12 furlongs. This is particularly a concern on this turf course with its short stretch. She could be vulnerable at a low price here but should be used in wagers especially in the "under" positions in Exotic bets. If you need a bomber for the bottom of Exotics to jack up the mutuel return, look no further than **#12 Catnip**. Just the far outside post will bolster his odds as will that 8th place last out. After pairing big tops, a regression was expected and that is exactly what happened. Look for a huge recovery off the long break and cut back in distance. Is sitting on a big race while offering a huge price.

## ANALYSIS

It's not the strongest edition of the Pegasus World Cup but it is setting up to be a very favorable wagering opportunity aided by the fact that we have a full field of 12 horses lining up. With that short run into the first turn in this 9-furlong affair, those drawn to the far outside 11 and 12 posts will be disadvantaged. The pace will be swift and there will be plenty of pace pressure. **#7 National Treasure** will lead the way with **#8 First Mission** pressing a length behind...then a length behind that pair you'll find **#4 Hoist the Gold**, **#9 Grand Aspen** and **#12 Skippylongstocking**. At the back marker some 8-10 lengths off the early pace you'll find the deep closers **#3 Dynamic One**, **#6 Señor Buscador** and **#11 Crupi**. The Super Screener analysis concludes that **#8 First Mission** is a clear Top Win/Top Board Hitter pick and then after that, it is a pretty wide open, competitive field and wagering recommendations are constructed to reflect that outcome. While we have seen the best from many of these older, well traveled horses in the field, **#8 First Mission** is a lightly raced 4-year-old that is getting very good at the right time. This is just his 6th career start and only his 3rd race since April. He has yet to miss the Exacta and will not miss it here. This is a very gifted and versatile horse by Street Sense that owns his sire's late turn of foot which has helped him win against slow-paced biases and, yet, he has that tactical speed that was on full display in this last start in which he narrowly missed the victory in the G2 Clark Stakes to horse-for-course, **#5 Trademark**. In that race he submitted a huge, triple-digit pace top coupled with a BRIS Late Pace figure of 94 and it was achieved at today's 9 furlongs distance. After dueling throughout and then still being able to come up with that kind of late-race stamina bodes well for an even better performance here as he advances slightly in his form cycle. He'll sit a very comfortable pressing position in the clear while being able to enjoy fast but easier fractions than what he dueled through last out. His recent series of works have been brilliant adding further evidence for a top performance here. Trainer Todd Pletcher will have 3 horses in this field and it is the lightly raced 5-yr-old **#9 Grand Aspen** that scores out the highest here. The slow developing 5-yr-old logged his two best performances following the removal of blinkers. In the local prep for this race, the G3 Harlan Holiday, he did all the dirty work in the early stages of the race, took the lead on the final turn but barely got out kicked to the wire by a pace-advantaged **#2 O'Connor**. The cut back to 8.5 furlongs didn't help his chances and added ground here really works in his favor as his two wins (dirt and turf) have come going 9 furlongs. He has worked forwardly since that contest and he'll be pressing right along side **#8 First Mission** and he owns the best shot at the upset here. The Super Screener Top Long Shot pick in the race is **#9 Grand Aspen's** stablemate, **#11 Crupi**. This 4-yr-old colt out of Curlin is best at this 9 furlongs distance and he is in top form right now. With a lively and pressured pace, this is the closer that appeals most as he won't be as far back as **#6 Señor Buscador** and **#3 Dynamic One** and his turn of foot is superior. Form Cycle Analysis is indicating that he'll move forward here by 5 points or more which puts him squarely in the win consideration set and certainly a key Trifecta player. Offers great value. **#10 Il Miracolo** is the other Top Long Shot pick in the race. He finally got that needed break after a very long 2023 campaign in which he raced without any time off. So, he owns plenty of foundation and that 60-day break had to do him some good so look for one of his better performances here on a surface which is the source of most of his Exacta finishes.
