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

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ MICHIGAN over Maryland - Michigan has dominated the series, winning the last 6 SU/ATS by an avg margin of 30 ppg, incl a 59-18 beatdown in College Park last year. Maryland is off to a 3-0 start, following a 34-27 (-2) win over SMU last week, **which delivered as our 5★ Sept Game of the Month, Free to All Power Sweep Subscribers!** Now Maryland enters Big 10 play, where they are on a 1-10 ATS run. Maryland has also struggled vs Top 25 tms under Locksley, going just 1-10 SU/ATS. MICH comes in off another easy win vs a weak non-conf foe, as they dispatched UCONN 59-0 & have now outscored their opps by a combined score of 166-17. We expect their series domination to continue & call for the Wolverines to crush the Terps. **FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 28**

3★ Minnesota over MICHIGAN ST - 1st mtg since '17. MIN has covered 7 of the L/8 in the series, incl a 14-3 (+16.5) loss last time in E Lansing. The Gophers rushed for 334 yds in a 49-7 home win over COL, incl 202 (8.8 ypc) from RB Ibrahim & are now avg 313 ypg on the ground thru 3 gms. MIN's Def is all'g just 170 ypg, incl just 101 pass ypg (44.1%). MSU is off a 39-28 loss at WAS, in which the Spartans trailed 29-8 at HT while being outgained 322-90 in 1H. The MSU pass D struggled, allowing 397 yds & 4 pass TDs & were unable to pressure the QB (0 sks). After rushing for 500 tll yds in their first 2 gms, the Spartans only mustered 42 yds on 29 carries (1.4 ypc) vs the Huskies. MIN is 10-3-1 ATS on the road the L3Y. We won a 4★ LPS going against MSU last week and will go against Sparty again here!

FORECAST: Minnesota by 10

3★ OLD DOMINION over Arkansas St - First meeting. This will be ODU's first SBC home game while Ark St is on the road for the 3rd straight week after playing at Memphis LW and lost 44-32. ODU enters 1-2 with a win over VA Tech & nearly beat Virginia LW, but their offense is only avg'g 286 ypg/18 ppg. However, they are facing an Ark St defense that is allowing 543 ypg/45 ppg to FBS foes & their DEF comes in ranked #117. Ark St also has all'd 365 pass ypg (68%) to FBS foes & now have to contend with one of the top WR's in the SBC in Ali Jennings (419, 21.0, 4 td). ODU does play well at home as they 6-1 ATS at home since the start of '21 & we like them to get their offense going here & win their first SBC home game by almost 2 td's!

FORECAST: OLD DOMINION by 13

2★ AUBURN over Missouri - This is only the 3rd meeting as SEC members. Auburn won the last meeting in '17, 51-14 (-17). Auburn let us down last week vs Penn St in their 41-12 (+3) loss. Auburn only punted once in the 1H and trailed 14-6 due to two TO's and settling for two short fg's. Mizzou beat FCS Abil Christian 34-17 (-31) though they did allow a garbage time td w/1:37 left. Both teams lost to the only P5 team they've faced but Auburn at least played better than the final score indicated last week. This is Auburn's 4th straight home game and Drinkwitz is 3-8 ATS on the road at Mizzou. Mizzou has also dropped 7 straight SEC road openers (2-5 ATS). With Auburn laying just a td and angry off a loss we think this is a cheap line, as we have the home Tigers by 2 td's.

FORECAST: AUBURN by 14

2★ OREGON ST (+) over Usc - USC's new-look offense continues to roll following 45-17 home win LW vs Fresno (QB Williams 284 pass & 2 TD) but the Bulldogs did lose QB Haener early 3Q. OSU is also 3-0 on the year after a 40 pt win a week ago over a solid Montana St squad where QB Nolan threw for 276 yds & 4 TD's (OSU +269 yds). The HT in this series is on a 14-3 SU (11-6 ATS) run although OSU (+11) did pick up a surprising 45-27 upset win a year ago (most pts ever by OSU against USC) for their 1st win in the Coliseum since way back in 1960. OSU has covered 7 straight at home and are 5-1 as an AD.

OTHER SELECTIONS

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 22ND

West Virginia at VIRGINIA TECH - These two former Big East rivals met last year when WV (-2) took a 27-7 lead but they were only up 6 when VT was SOD at the WV3. The Hokies are off a win over FCS Wofford and are 1-10 ATS off a SU win the last 3 years now. The Mountaineers nearly upset Pitt in their opener before getting upset themselves by an improving Kansas squad in OT. WV was angry last week after B2B close losses, and crushed FCS Towson 65-7 (-39). The Hokies are 7-3 SU/6-4 ATS in this series but are only just 11-9 SU at home vs Power 5 foes since 2018. Neal Brown is 16-8 as an AD but only 7-6 here. Call 1-800-654-3448 to see if we use this rivalry as our Thurs Night Marquee!

Coastal Carolina at GEORGIA ST - Teams have met 5 times & the home team is 0-5 SU and are 0-4-1 ATS. GST is at home for a 3rd straight wk & are off a 42-41 loss vs Charlotte where they all'd 501 yds incl 401 passing. CC held on to beat Buffalo LW 38-26 & we picked up a 2★ PS winner on Buffalo (+13.5). Both teams are playing on short rest, but GST gets the benefit of playing at home while CC has to travel. CC is all'g 392 ypg & 27 ppg and CC gave up 202 rush yds (5.2) to Army in the opener & vs FCS Gardner-Webb they all'd 448 pass yds. GST is 3-0 for 343 last wk, but the OL has all'd just 4 sks and they are avg'g 231 rush ypg (4.7). GST is 8-4 ATS at home vs SBC foes since '20 but are now 0-3 on the season while CC keeps finding ways to win games this season.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 23RD

SYRACUSE by 14 over Virginia - UVA is 3-0 SU but 0-3 ATS in this series and L/met in '15. Cuse has a great chance to get to 5-0 with Wagner on deck before their schedule significantly toughens. The Orange found a way last week against Purdue, winning 32-29 (-1), giving us a 3★ Power Sweep winner. UVA needed a 26 yd fg as time expired to beat ODU 16-14 (-8) LW but they did finish with a 513-324 yd edge. Last year QB Armstrong had a 31-10 ratio but after losing OC Robert Anae and a rebuilt Oline he only has a 2-3 ratio and his completion percentage has dropped from 65% to 53%. Anae is now the OC at Syracuse and he's helped QB Shrader improve from 53% and a 9-4 ratio last year to 66% and an 8-0 ratio this year! UVA is on a 1-6 ATS run including 0-3 this year while Syracuse has covered all 3 games this year so our lean is with the home Orange.

AIR FORCE by 27 over Nevada - As MW foes AF is 4-2 SU/ATS against Nevada. This has been a high-scoring series as these teams have avg'd 78 points in their L/6 mtgs. We don't anticipate this game being as high-scoring as Nev's offense is only putting up 227 ypg vs FBS foes & the AF defense is allowing 303 ypg/15 ppg. The AF option is looking good early on this season as they are avg'g 396 rush ypg (6.9) led by FB Roberts (342, 7.1) but they were held to 171 (4.3) LW in a loss at WY where they were missing several st's. Nev's rush D struggled to slow down FCS Incarnate Word 2 wks ago (210, 4.8). AF does have their rival Navy on deck but we see the Falcons being able to run all over the 'Pack & the Nev offense will be limited against a strong AF defense.

Boise St by 18 over UTEP - Boise is 6-0 SU vs UTEP & have won those games by at least 15 pts. LY Boise hosted UTEP & despite being just +125 yds for the game Boise won 54-13 (+5 TO's). UTEP is off a rivalry game vs NMex where they lost 27-10 & were held to 253 yds while Boise won 30-7 vs UT Martin and are now back on the road for the 3rd time in 4 games. Boise struggled on DEF vs Oreg St but have all'd 275 total yds the L/2 gms & face a UTEP offense avg'g just 281 ypg/14 ppg the L/3 gms. Boise has tried to get their run gm going (132 ypg, 3.5 ypc) and face a UTEP run D all'g 199 ypg (4.9). Boise has a big game on deck against vs MW foe SDSU but Boise has an impressive 23-13-1 ATS mark since 2014 as a road favorite & UTEP has failed to cover 4 of their L/5 games as a DD Dog.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 24TH

Baylor by 3 over IOWA ST - BU has covered the last 4 mtgs vs ISU & the L/3 games have been decided by 7 pts or less. BU regrouped with a win LW vs TXSt 42-7 while Iowa St won 43-10 vs Ohio. Both tms are playing stellar D (BU #17, ISU #19) as ISU is allowing 234 ypg/9 ppg and their run D is

giving up 60 ypg (3.3). BU's defense is all'g 290 ypg/14 ppg and their run D is giving up 84 ypg (2.6). Both tms are also breaking in new QB's & they are both hitting over 67% through 3 gms. ISU's RB Brock is trying to replace star RB Hall & he is off to a good start (280, 5.6) while BU has 3 RB's over 130 yds this ssn. The difference could be ST's here as BU has the big edge (#25 vs #127). We see this game coming down to the wire & we'll back the team that has covered 4 straight in the series.

KENTUCKY by 20 over Northern Illinois - First mtg. NIU plays an SEC foe for the 2nd straight wk after losing to Vandy 38-28 (-2), giving us a 4★ LP Totals winner (Over 59) which are now 7-4-1 on the season! NIU led 28-14 3Q then allowed Vandy to score on 4 straight poss's. KY was 30 pt chalk LW and beat FCS YSU 31-0, taking it easy on Stoops hometown school in the 2H. The 'Cats are 15-1 SU/11-4-1 ATS vs MAC schools but NIU is 10-3 ATS vs the SEC. KY already beat one MAC school this year in the opener but they only led Miami 13-10 at half in that game. The 'Cats have Ole Miss on deck and NIU is back in their preferred role as a dog so we only have KY by under 3 td's here.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 21 over Charlotte - First meeting. SC enters off back-to-back losses to SEC foes after getting beat 48-7 (+24). The Gamecocks did put up 306 yards on the UGA D but they were playing without 5 defensive starters and allowed 547 yards. CLT was 0-3 entering last week and a 20 pt dog but got QB Chris Reynolds back and he threw for 401 and 5 td's including the game-winner with :17 left for a 42-41 victory. The 49ers allowed 602 yards LW and they've given up 45 ppg and 565 ypg! QB Rattler only has a 2-5 ratio so far but he did throw for 376 vs Arkansas two weeks ago and CLT is allowing 322 pass ypg and 73%! SC only has SCST on deck but their defensive injuries and the return of Reynolds has us leaning with the dog.

TEMPLE by 10 over Massachusetts - Temple is 2-0 in series incl a 29-21 win their last mtg in '17. After failing to cover vs Tulane & Toledo, UMass ended an 8 gm losing streak with a 20-3 "upset" of Stony Brook as a 2' pt HD, with a 333-264 yd edge benefitting from a 98 yd IR td. The Owls had their only SU win 2 wks ago over Lafayette, but have covered 2 straight only losing to Rutgers 16-14 as an 18 pt HD. They did hold Rutgers to 4 FG at (made 3). Owls have opened just under a DD Fav (9) and are the "better" of 2 bad teams, but their are better options for your interest.

GEORGIA by 42 over Kent St - Whoever made this schedule for Kent St should apologize to the players. Kent St plays their 3rd paycheck game in 4 weeks after losing at Wash & OK by 25 & 30 in the first 2 games. They did beat LIU 63-10 (-39) last week but the Bulldogs are just a tad better than the Sharks. UGA beat SCar 48-7 (-24) last week, and they are +40 ppg & +283 ypg so far. The Golden Flash did cover against OK two weeks ago. HC Smart is just 4-8 as 40+ chalk and this is an SEC sandwich game. He will empty their bench early so we are cutting our line off at 42.

Notre Dame by 3 over NORTH CAROLINA - ND is 20-2 in series incl 4 straight wins & 3 straight covers. LTH ('20) UNC never trailed in 1H but were shutout in 2H losing 31-17 (+5). LY UNC led #11 ND 20-17 3Q but lost 44-34 (+3). Tar Heels are 3-0 (1-1-1 ATS) incl a 63-61 "Upset" of App St as a 2' pt AD & are off a bye. While the Irish got HC Freeman his first win LW, it was not the feel good one they desired, beating Cal 24-17 as a 12 pr HF (297-296 yd edge). With their starting QB OFY, ND QB Pyne in his first car start hit 17-20 (2-0 ratio) but for just 150 yds. While this will be Pyne's first road start UNC has allowed an avg 275 ypg pass (68%) & an 11-2 ratio. UNC has the Off edge (#7-#53) but ND has the bigger Def edge (#11-#98) & in a close game we'll side with the better defense.

MIAMI, FL by 30 over Middle Tennessee - These two haven't met since 1932. MT was left for dead after getting blown out by JMU in their opener but have rebounded nicely, upsetting Colo St on the road then beat Tenn St 49-6 (-19). Miami enters angry off a loss at A&M 17-9 but they did finish with a 392-264 yard edge. The 'Canes became the first team since 2000 to record 27+ FD's and 0 td's. HC Cristobal has clearly had an effect on the defense as they are allowing 279 ypg and have 8 sacks in 3 games. The 'Canes do have a bye on deck and MT is 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS vs Power 5 foes.

NC STATE by 35 over UConn - NCSt is 2-0 in this series, last winning back in '12. The 'Pack are in a huge sandwich here, off a 27-14 (-10) win over Texas Tech and they've got an ACC Atlantic showdown with Clemson on deck. This is UConn's 3rd straight game against a Power 5 foe after losing to Michigan 59-0 (+47) and Syracuse 48-14 (+23) the two weeks prior. HC Doeren is 10-5 as a 20+ point favorite but with their biggest game of the season on deck we see the 'Pack taking it easy on this weak foe and UConn did stay within 5 td's against a 3-0 Cuse squad a few weeks ago.

PENN ST by 21 over Central Michigan - 1st mtg since 2005. Penn St is 29-3 all-time vs MAC foes, incl a 46-10 (-27) home win over OHIO a few wks ago. The Nittany Lions are off an impressive 41-12 road win over AUB. They only outgained the Tigers 477-415, but took advantage of 4 TOs & pounded out 245 yds (6.3 ypc) on the ground. CMU is coming off a 41-0 win over FCS Bucknell. The Chippewas only led 7-0 at HT, but outscored the Bison 34-0 in 2H & finished with a 529-174 yd edge. The Chippewas tend to be pesky vs P5 tms & covered earlier this ssn vs Okla St (58-44 loss, +21), which moved HC McElwain to 7-3 as an AD while at CMU. Penn St is off a physical matchup vs AUB & has a conf gm on deck (N'western), so we like the Chippewas to keep this one within the line.

UCF by 22 over Georgia Tech - 1st mtg in Orlando. Tms last met in '20 & UCF dominated, putting 660 tll yds & forcing 5 TOs in their 49-21 (-7) road win. UCF is coming off a 40-12 road win over FAU, in which they amassed 653 yds of tll Off. It was close at half then UCF 327-18 yd edge in the 2H and ended on the FAU5. The Knights have now rushed for over 200 yds in all 3 gms. GT comes in at 1-2 after a 42-0 home loss to Ole Miss in which they were outgained 547-214 & have now been outgained in all 3 gms TY, incl in their win over FCS W Carolina. We went against GT for a 3★ LPS LW and we are going against the Jackets again as Collins is 11-25-1 ATS here, incl 1-9 vs non-conf & 4-10 off a SU loss.

LOUISVILLE by 19 over Ucf - L'ville has won 3 str in the series. The Cardinals are off to a 1-2 start after a 35-31 (+3) home loss to Fla St. QC Cunningham is now hitting 60% of his passes with just a 1-2 ratio. The Cardinals' Def has struggled vs the run, all'g 201 ypg (5.3 ypc) on the ssn. USF is off a 31-28 (+24) loss at Florida, which moves the Bulls to 0-12 SU (5-6-1 ATS) on the road under HC Scott. USF actually led 28-24 in the 4Q, but QB Bohanon (Baylor transfer) threw a 4Q int, which set up the Gators gm winning TD with 5:05 left. The Bulls had a 49 yd FG chance for the tie with 23 secs left, but a bad hold led to a missed kick. Now after an emotional loss, USF hits the road again in a series that has been dominated by the HT (8-3 SU, 9-2 ATS), so we'll side with L'ville & HC Satterfield who is 20-13-1 ATS off a SU loss.

Clemson by 9 over WAKE FOREST - Clemson has won 13 straight over WF including LY when the Tigers were unranked but -4 against the #13 Demon Deacons. Clemson's Dline dominated with 8 sacks and Clemson won 48-27 with a 542-406 yd edge. WF was fortunate to avoid getting upset LW vs Liberty, with the Flames getting stopped on a 2 pt conversion to win the game. The Deacons were outgained 437-346 and out FD'd 22-16 but were +2 TO's. Lib missed 2 fg's and WF had td drives of 4 & 30 yards. Clem had a slow start last week, only led 13-6 at half and it was 34-6 4Q and the Tigers won 48-20 (-33). WF has already allowed 7 sacks in 3 games against weak defenses. Clemson's Dline has all 4 starters back so Sam Hartman may be running for his life again. We have Clemson winning this by a touchdown and the Tigers are 14-8-1 as an AF s'17.

OHIO ST by 26 over Wisconsin - OSU has won 8 str in the series (6-2 ATS) & are on a 5-0 SU/ATS run in Columbus, incl a 38-7 (-14) win LTH in '19. The Buckeyes are off 77-21 win over Toledo, in which they gained 763 tll yds. The revamped OSU D under new DC Knowles is all'g 279 ypg overall & 84 ypg (2.6 ypc) rush. OSU may be w/o RB Henderson (197, 6.8), as he left in 1Q & was in a walking boot after the gm. Wisc got back on the winning side LW, rolling an outmatched NMSU squad 66-7. Wisc rushed for 260 (5.7) & threw for 335 as QB Mertz threw for 3 TDs. The Badgers D is only surrendering 246 ypg, but faces a different level of Off with the Buckeyes, who are avg 48 ppg on the yr & 34 ppg in their 8 gm win streak against the Badgers. Wisc does not have the offensive firepower to keep up in this one, so we'll ride with OSU by nearly 4 td's.

LIBERTY by 24 over Akron - Zips won only prior mtg 49-21 in 2002. Since moving up to FBS LU is 2-0 SU & ATS vs MAC tms incl a 56-20 win (-9) over EM in LY's bowl. Despite just 11 starters back Liberty started with wins over S.Miss & UAB & LW came up a missed 2 pt conv from upsetting #19 WF. After opening with an OT win over an FCS tm, the Zips have been outscored 115-6 the L/2 wks but that was vs then #14 Mich St & #15 Tenn. Zips have their MAC opener on deck but should be more competitive here & they put up 276 yds vs Tenn. While Liberty is the better team, they put out a huge effort LW in an emotional loss. With this being just their 2nd HG, we look for them to get some young players some time, which should help the Zips to keep it closer than expected.

FLORIDA ST by 19 over Boston College - FSU is 11-1 SU and has covered 5 of the last 6 meetings. The 'Noles enter 3-0 with two close wins over LSU/LVille. Last week was a costly win over the Cardinals as QB Travis and DE Verse were among several key players injured in the 'Noles 35-31 (-3) win. Backup QB Rodemaker did throw for 109 yards and 67' WR Johnny Wilson had 7-149 and 2 td's. BC is off a 38-17 (-31) win over FCS Maine but only finished w/a 431-378 yd edge. The 'Noles lost their starting RT prior to that game and they've allowed 12 sacks in 3 games (10.7%). FSU is just 1-6 as a HF but BC is on a 0-5 ATS run and two weeks ago they put up just 155 yards at VTech so we will take the 'Noles to win this by over 2 td's.

TENNESSEE by 6 over Florida - Florida has dominated this series, winning 16 of the last 17 and are 12-5 ATS but the Vols are actually favored by double-digits for the first time in this series as far back as our records go. Tenn's only recent win did come in Neyland in '16 when the Vols rallied from down 21-3 at half and won 38-28. Florida escaped with a 31-28 (-24) win over USF and Tenn only had Akron last week who they beat 63-6 (-47'). Florida did beat Utah in the opener while Tenn beat Pitt in OT two weeks ago but the Panthers did lose their QB before half and the bkp was banged up as well. QB Richardson may have a huge game rushing against a Tenn team that struggled to stop dual threat QB's last year, allowing two to go for over 140 rush yds. Tenn is just 1-6 SU when favored vs Florida since 1991. We can't go against series history here so our lean is with the underdog Gators.

CINCINNATI by 10 over Indiana - These teams met last year & IND had the #8 Bearcats on the ropes, leading 14-0 1Q before a targeting call knocked their best player out of the game. They still led 14-10 H & 24-23 at the end of 3Q, before all'g 15 unanswered in the 4Q. The Hoosiers out'd CIN 376-328, but all'd a 99 yd KOR TD & committed 4 TOs & IND would go on to lose 9 of their last 10 gms. The Hoosiers escaped with a 33-30 OT (-6') win over W Kentucky, after trailing nearly the entire game. IND got the tying TD & 2pt conv with just 47 secs left to push it to OT. CIN is off a 38-17 (-23') home win over Miami (OH). The Bearcats actually trailed 17-7 early 2Q, but rattled off 17 str pts to take a 24-17 HT & pitched a 2H shut out, all'g just 183 ttl yds. The CIN D is now all'g 294 ypg. IND certainly has revenge on their minds after last yr's loss seemed to derail their ssn & they are 10-6 ATS vs non-conf under HC Allen, so we think the Hoosiers keep this one within the line.

EAST CAROLINA by 17 over Navy - Navy is 7-2 SU/ATS in the series. ECU did pull out a 38-35 (-3.5) win last year at Navy, despite all'g 345 rushing yds (7.8). The Pirates are coming off a 49-10 win over FCS Campbell, in which they rushed for 270 yds (7.1 ypc) as they out'd The Camels 572-403. EC QB Ahlers is now completing 67% w/a 7-2 ratio. Navy is off a much needed bye, as they dropped their first 2 gms & are avg'g just 100 ypg. The Midshipmen came into the year with a young squad (#89 exp) & can use the additional practice time to fine tune their option attack. The NAVY D has been stout against the run (52 ypg, 1.7 ypc), but all'd 415 pass yds to MEM, despite 4 sks. The road team is 6-3 ATS in the series, but we see this one pretty close to the line.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 11 over Ball St - Will be the 1st mtg. GSthm has hosted a MAC foe only one other time & that was WMich back in '15 & they won 43-17. BSU got their 1st win of the ssn LW vs Murray St 31-0 (+32.1) while GSthm outgained UAB but were -3 TO's and lost by 14 pts. GSthm's offense hasn't skipped a beat since moving away from the option as they are avg'g 521 ypg/422 ppg and the OL has all'd ZERO sacks on 152 pass att and BSU's DEF has given up 503 ypg/48 ppg vs FBS foes this season. However GSthm's DEF has struggled vs FBS foes, all'g 494 ypg/39 ppg vs FBS foes & the BSU offense has gained 462 ypg the L/2 wks. We see the Eagles being able to make 1 or 2 more plays on offense & getting the DD win at home.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 2 over Buffalo - MAC opener for both. Bulls are 3-1 SU & ATS vs Eagles including a 43-14 win (E) in their last meeting (also here) in 2019. The Bulls are 0-3 SU but 2-1 ATS incl covering vs Maryland in the opener. LW Buffalo (+13.5) was 1 of our 3 Marquee winners on Saturday, as they covered vs Coastal Carolina despite allowing a 21 yd FR td & a 59 yd td pass in the 4Q. LW EM stayed up late on the West Coast and gave us one of 3 outright upset winners of out "Big Dog" Selections as they beat Ariz St 30-21 as a 20' pt AD finishing with a 458-352 yd edge. Along with the coming down from that long trip and emotional win the Eagles have lost 5 straight MAC openers (1-4 ATS) incl a 35-28 loss to Buffalo in '18 the week after upsetting Purdue. They are also just 2-6 ATS as a HF since '19, so we will take the Bulls & the points.

APPALACHIAN ST by 14 over James Madison - These teams met 16 times as FCS foes, with App St winning 12 of them. App St is at home for the 3rd time in 4 games and LW needed a miracle Hail Mary to beat Troy while JMU is off a bye. JMU has been dominant in their F/2 games, outscoring their foes 107-14 & the offense is avg'g 505 ypg/54 ppg behind QB Centeio (452, 66%, 9-0) and WR Thornton (257, 5 td). JMU's defense also has held foes to 169 ypg/7 ppg but this is by far their toughest test & is their first road SBC game. App St has a veteran QB, 2 strong RB's and a defense that is all'g 273 ypg the L/2 wks. App St had a lot of noise surrounding their last week that no doubt was distracting, and with that behind him we see them refocusing this week and winning by 2 td's.

Iowa by 2 over RUTGERS - Iowa has won both previous mtgs, but HT is 2-0 ATS. LTH here ('16), Iowa won 14-7 (-13). The Hawkeyes come in off a 27-0 (-23) win over Nevada, which saw the OFF hit double-digits for the 1st time all ssn. Iowa comes in avg'g just 14 ppg & 218 ypg on the year &

only mustered 337 yds vs a Nevada team that all'd 616 yds to FCS tm the prvs wk. The Iowa D has been strong, all'g just 195 ypg & 4 ppg. RUT struggled on the road vs Temple LW, as they were out'd by the Owls 264-201 & only had 59 yds throw the air. RUT D is all'g 14 ppg & just 21 rush ypg (1.1 ypc). Both offenses have had their challenges & now both face stingy defenses, so we expect a low scoring contest that could come down to the wire.

KANSAS by 4 over Duke - 4th all-time mtg. Tms met LY in Durham and Duke trailed at HT 24-21 but came back to win 52-33. KU is 3-0 for the first time since '09 and they tied the '07 Orange Bowl team with 159 pts scored in their F/3 games. We won a 3★ Total on the Over 58 in the KU-HOU gm last wk (KU won 48-30). KU also gave us a Big Dog Comp Play outright upset winner LW (Free on Thursdays, Button 9, 1-347-677-1700). KU is led by QB Daniels who has 586 pass (67%, 7-1) and also leads KU with 237 rush (8.8)! Duke's defense did allow 511 to N'Western 2 wks ago & LW all'd 217 rush yds (5.3) to NC A&T. KU's defense is all'g 474 ypg and 36 ppg the L/2 gms vs FBS foes & Duke is avg'g 460 ypg on offense & 37 ppg. This is the first time KU is a HF vs a Power 5 team since '18 (Rutgers) & this is an unfamiliar spot for them, while Duke already went on the road & upset N'Western as a +10-pt road dog and we see the Blue Devils keeping this one close.

NORTHWESTERN by 10 over Miami, OH - 1st mtg since 2009. NW has won the last 2 SU. The Wildcats are coming off a stunning 31-24 loss to FCS squad Southern Illinois. NW outgained the Salukis 380-357, but turned the ball over 4 times, incl 2 ints by QB Hilinski. The Wildcats have now lost 2 str non-conf home gms after an opening win over NEB in Dublin, Ireland. MIA led CIN 17-7 in the 2Q LW, but were shutout the rest of the way in a 38-17 (+23') road loss. MIA ply'd w/o strating QB Gabbert, who is expected to miss here, as well. Redshirt from Aveon Smith took his place, but completed just 9-21 for 116 yds & an int. This will be the Redhaws 2nd gm vs a P5 foe TY, as they lost 37-13 (+15) to KY to open the ssn. N'western is just 2-8 ATS vs MAC tms since 2008, so we like the Redhaws to hang around in this one.

Ucla by 25 over COLORADO - It's been a rough start to the ssn for the Buffs as their offense has avg'd just 10 ppg (245 ypg) while their defense has given up 43 ppg (152 ypg) during their 0-3 start that includes LW's 42 pt defeat on the road to the Gophers. The Bruins meanwhile are off to a 3-0 start although they did need a 24-yd GW FG as time expired to beat S Alabama LW (UCLA 15' pt favorite). UCLA leads the all-time series 12-5 but have dropped the past 3 in Boulder. LY the Bruins (UCLA 501-358 yd edge). With the Bruins covering 6 of their 9 P12 gms a year ago and the Buffs failing to cover 6 of their past 8 as a dog, the visitor gets the edge in this one.

BYU by 28 over Wyoming - The former conf foes have met 78 times, but have not met since 2016 when BYU won 24021 in the Poinsettia Bowl. BYU went into Oregon banged up LW and lost 41-20 while WY took on an AF team missing several key str's and they pulled the outright upset 17-14 for their 3rd win in a row! After giving up 477 & 521 yds the F/2 gms WY has all'd under 275 yds the L/2 gms and they have 10 sks the L/3 gms. After 2 tough foes (Baylor, Oregon) BYU takes on an easier foe here & against USF in the opener they put up 575 yds & 50 pts. While Sitake is just 2-6 ATS s/ 19 off a SU loss, WY is 4-1 ATS as a DD dog since '19. However, BYU is 4-2 ATS in their L/6 gms as a favorite of 20+ pts and this could be their chance to regain momentum.

NEW MEXICO ST by 8 over Hawaii - This is the 5th straight game for both but Hawaii has a bye on deck. Hawaii has won all 10 mtgs but are just 2-3 ATS s/09. Both are under 1st year HC's but while this is just Timmy Chang's 5th game as HC it is Jerry Kill's 106th, giving NMST the huge coaching edge. Hawaii is 1-3 SU & 2-2 ATS. They beat FCS Duquesne 24-14 LW as a 8 pt HF but led just 14-6 into 4Q before a 50 yd IR td decided the game as they were actually outgained 364-184!!!! The Aggies are 0-4 SU & 1-3 ATS but played a much tougher schedule (#20-#74) incl facing a Wisconsin tm off an embarrassing loss taking their frustrations out on them LW. The week prior vs UTEP the Aggies had a 298-261 yd edge and only lost 20-13 as a 17' pt AD, while Hawaii's closest loss was 49-17 as a 16' pt HD to WKU. We will take the under a FG HF here.

Utah by 10 over ARIZONA ST - The Utes have clearly rebounded from their opening loss at Florida with a pair of convincing wins vs S.Utah (73-7) and SDSt a week ago (22-9 FD & 398-173 yd edges in 35-7 win). ASU meanwhile suffered a 30-21 home loss vs E.Mich where they had 27-18 FD and 457-352 yd disadvantages & HC Edwards was fired the next day! While ASU does own a 22-10 all-time series advantage and were up 21-7 at HT LY at SLC, the Utes scored 28 unanswered pts to pick up the 35-21 win (Utah 455-360 yd edge). This will actually mark the 1st time in 3 ssn that ASU is a HD although they were an impressive 8-4 ATS in that role from '16-'19. With the Utes failing to cover 5 of their past 6 as an AF dating back to LY we still expect ASU to keep it within the line.

SAN DIEGO ST by 3 over Toledo - First mtg. SDSt is 4-1 SU vs MAC foes since 2016, but only have covered 2 of those gms. Toledo is off a 77-21 drubbing at the hands of Ohio St (-456 yds) while SDSt also was defeated soundly by Utah 35-7 (-225 yds). SDSt has seen their offense struggle vs 2 Power 5 tms, gaining just 405 total yds vs Ariz & Utah. The SDSt defense has also taken a step back, as they are allowing 399 ypg. Toledo's offense is avg'g 195 rush ypg (5.0) & SDSt has a solid rush D (139, 3.8). To us SDSt is desperate for a win here and are catching Toledo off a 56-pt loss, so we'll take the home team to get a close win here.

Oregon by 3 over WASHINGTON ST - Following a big 21 pt victory LW at home against BYU where QB Nix had 5 td TD's, the Ducks head into Pullman to take on a Cougars squad that they've picked up victories in 11 of the past 15 against (WSU has actually covered 11 of the L/15!). The Cougars remain undefeated on the year after a HUGE road upset in Madison against Wisconsin and an easy 38-7 home win LW against Colo St where QB Ward threw for 299 yds and 4 TD. In their meeting of a ssn ago, the Ducks (-14') overcame a 14-14 HT tied with 24 pts in the 2H of an eventual 38-24 victory. With the home tm winning 3 of their past 4 overall and WSU a solid 6-2 ATS when listed as a HD, we expect the Cougs to stay within the line here against a Ducks squad that's 4-9-1 ATS in recent P12 contests.

UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over 40 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years. Here is this week's Underdog Play:

Tulsa +20' over MISSISSIPPI

Tulsa (+) over MISSISSIPPI - These two haven't met since the 1964 BlueBonnet Bowl. The Rebels gave us an easy 3★ LPS winner last week in their 42-0 (-17) annihilation of Georgia Tech. Ole Miss held a 547-214 yd edge. Tulsa was only laying 10 pts last week vs future FBS member Jacksonville St but they had no trouble, putting up 621 yards and 54 pts in a 37 point win. The Golden Hurricane are +164 ypg and Davis Brin has an 11-1 ratio. This is Tulsa's preferred role as they are 11-1 as an away dog since '19. Tulsa nearly beat Miss St in the Armed Forced Bowl and had a 484-271 yd edge two years ago. They gave #2 Cincy a tough battle last year, losing by 8. They won't be intimidated and we think they keep it closer than expected against an Ole Miss squad that has their SEC opener vs Kentucky on deck.

CALIFORNIA by 1 over Arizona - After a narrow 7 pt defeat LW in South Bend against the Irish where they led 10-7 at HT and nearly completed a Hail Mary as time expired (ND 297-296 yd edge), the Bears return home seeking revenge against a Wildcats team that took advantage of 8 Cal starters missing due to Covid. Arizona (+8) would get a TD w/2:17 left for the 10-3 home victory (Wildcats ended 20-gm losing skid, Cal outgained 331-122). The Wildcats picked up a 31-28 home win as a 2 pt HD against FCS juggernaut ND State with a GW TD w/4:53 remaining. The Bears continue to struggle as a HF dating back to the midway point of '17. During that span they've failed to cover 13 of 16 contests including 5 outright upsets. While we feel that they'll earn the win in this one, laying points in their favor is way too risky.

WASHINGTON by 10 over Stanford - The Cardinal return to action following an early ssn bye. Prior to their week off, they suffered a 41-28 home defeat against the Trojans despite finishing with a 505-441 yd advantage (-4 TO's). The Huskies meanwhile jumped out to a 29-8 HT lead over Mich St in the eventual 11 pt victory (UW 503-365 yd edge). The Cardinal have actually won 12 of the past 17 in this series (11-6 ATS) including 3 outright upsets since '17. They did however drop a 20-13 (-2) home matchup a year ago with the Huskies getting a GW TD with :22 remaining (UW 375-261 yd edge). With the Huskies failing to cover 7 of their past 10 P12 matchups overall and Stanford's previous series success, we're expecting Stanford to keep it within the line.

Marshall by 10 over TROY - Have met 5 times, but not since 2004. One week after their upset over Notre Dame, the Herd were in a prime let down spot & fell to Bowling Green 34-31 despite being +170 yds as they were -3 TO's and 2 of those TO's were inside the 10 yd line. Troy nearly upset App St LW but lost on the final play & are now 1-2. MU's offense is avg'g 508 ypg and 37 ppg led by their RB LaBorn (422, 6.3, 5 td), RB Ali could be back and QB Colombi is hitting 78% (688, 4-2) and Troy's D is all'g 445 ypg to FBS foes. Troy's pass offense has been good (351 ypg, 66%) but they are only running for 58 ypg (2.0) & MU's D is all'g just 281 ypg/19 ppg and they had a stellar CB duo & their run D allows just 79 ypg (2.5) & they have 6 sks. MU got their reality check LW and we think they bounce back with a road win here by DD's & MU is 4-2 ATS as an AF under HC Huff.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 16 over Louisiana Tech - LT has won the two previous meetings back in '17-'18. SALA enters off a near upset of UCLA where they led 17-6 2Q and were up 31-29 but were SOD at the UCLA22 then allowed the Bruins to go 10 plays/61 yds for the GW fg as time expired. LT only trailed Clemson 13-6 at half but were down 34-6 4Q and lost 48-20 (+35'). SALA is +166 ypg and their offense averaged 470 ypg while LT is allowing 461 ypg including 249 rush ypg (5.9). LT has lost 8 straight vs Non-ConFBS foes and they are 3-13-1 ATS off a SU loss since '19. They've failed to cover 5 of their L/6 on the road while HC Wommack is 6-1 ATS at home. LT is on a 7-16 ATS run and we are going with the Jaguars to win by over 2 td's here.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 27 over Bowling Green - BG enters off an upset win over Marshall (+17, +540) as one of our 3 outright winners in our Big Dogs (Just \$12 on Thursdays, call 1-800-654-3448). The Falcons rallied from a 14-0 deficit early and won 34-31 though they did get outgained 547-377 (+3 TO's). QB McDonald has a 10-0 ratio and is also their leading rusher. Miss St enters off a loss after falling at LSU 31-16 (-3). The Bulldogs struggled with LSU's talented front 7 and put up just 289 yards. BG is 9-4 as dogs the last two years including a cover against Tenn and they only trailed UCLA by 7 at half in the opener. With A&M on deck we don't think Miss St is fully focused here so our lean is with the underdog Falcons.

OKLAHOMA by 8 over Kansas St - While OU has won 5 of the L/7 mtgs SU, KSt has covered 3 straight & 4 of the L/5 gms. OU is off a 49-14 win at Neb (+253 yds) while KSt was caught in a look-ahead spot & lost to Tulane 17-10. While OU's offense is looking good early on this season (501 ypg/42 ppg) this is by far the toughest DEF they have faced as KSt is #10 in our DEF rankings & they are holding foes to 276 ypg/10 ppg and are +6 TO's & have 7 sks. OU's defense has been great early this season (313 ypg/10 ppg) & have collected 13 sks, but KSt has a stellar run gm (239, 5.5) led by star RB Vaughn (352, 5.7) and their OL has all'd 0 sks the L/2 gms. While we see OU getting the win, KSt is 12-7 ATS as an underdog under HC Klieiman & we see this game being decided by right around a TD.

ALABAMA by 41 over Vanderbilt - The last time these two met was in '17. Vandy entered 3-0 and former HC Mason angered Bama players with comments prior to the game which led to a 62-0 (-18) thrashing. Bama crushed ULM 63-7 (-49) though the Tide's offense still had some issues as QB Bryce Young threw 2 int's. Bama had 2 td's on ST's and Will Anderson had a pick-6. The 'Dores started true frosh QB AJ Swann last week at NIU. He threw for 255 yds and 4 td's. Vandy trailed 28-14 3Q then scored 24 unanswered to win by 10 as 2 pt dogs. Bama is on an 0-5 ATS run vs Power 5 foes in reg season and Vandy is now 8-2 as an AD and the Tide do have a trip to Ark on deck. We cashed our 4★ top Totals play on Vandy/NIU Over 59 last week, could we go back to the 'Dores for this week's Totals GOM?

TCU by 3 over SMU - 106th battle for the Iron Skillet! The rivalry turned up another notch TY as former SMU coach Dykes is now the HC at TCU. SMU is off a 34-27 loss to Maryland where we picked up a 5★ winner on the Terps!! TCU enters off a bye and are 2-0 on the season. QB Morris started the season as the starter, but was banged up & Duggan started 2 wks ago. SMU's run D is all'g 214 ypg (5.1) vs FBS foes & TCU is avg'g 268 rush ypg (6.8). SMU was +81 yds LW but were done in by 3 TO's by QB Mordecai and TCU has one of the better pass D's in the Big 12. TCU won 18 of 21 mtgs SU from 1997-2018 but have lost the L/2 mtgs both SU/ATS. We think TCU has the speed edge on offense & their defense is exp'd, plus they are out for revenge and the home team is on an 0-6-1 ATS slide.

Texas by 10 over TEXAS TECH - This is a matchup Texas has owned of late, going 10-2 SU/9-3 ATS since 2010. Texas was tied with UTSA at HT, but pulled away 2H and won 41-20. Texas is w/o QB Ewers and QB Card is now the starter, but the offense goes through RB B.Robinson who ran for 183 (9.2) last week. TT is off a 27-14 loss at NCSt where they were +83 yds but were -3 TO's incl a pick-6. While the DEF for TT looks to be improved (all'g just 274 ypg, 22 ppg), they have allowed 70 & 63 pts to Texas in the L/2 mtgs, the highest two point totals all'd in series history. The L/4 gms overall have seen an avg of 93 points scored! While TT looks to be improved, QB Smith is prone to INT's (5 int's the L/2 gms) and Texas looks like the stronger team overall & we'll side with the series history and take the Longhorns to cover.

Louisiana by 21 over ULM - 57th Battle of the Bayou. LA has won 7 of the L/8 mtgs SU but the home tm is a shocking 2-20-1 ATS in the L/23 mtgs! LA is on the road for a 2nd straight wk after

losing to Rice LW 33-21 where the offense was held to 175 yds & 9 FD's while ULM was throttled by Alabama 63-7 (-340 yds). The Cajuns defense is all'g 358 ypg, but gave up 449 yds to Rice LW and their pass D is all'g 313 ypg vs FBS foes. LA has done well forcing TO's as the Cajuns are +9 in TO's and ULM is only avg'g 214 ypg vs FBS foes, but that was vs Texas & Bama. ULM held Texas to 383 yds but LW vs Bama all'd 509 and LA's offense did put up 454 yds vs EMich 2 wks ago. It is impossible to ignore the series history & we will side with the road team by 3 td's.

†Texas A&M by 7 over Arkansas - This game is played in AT&T Stadium in Dallas every year. Ark had lost 9 straight meetings entering LY but the Hogs 443-272 yd edge and won 20-10 (+4'). LW Ark faced Missouri ST who is coached by Hogs former HC Bobby Petrino and they actually trailed MOST 17-0 2Q but rallied & won 38-27 (-25'). A&M was off a loss to App St last week and HC Fisher switched to Max Johnson at QB. Their D was strong once again, holding the 'Canes to 3 short fg's. The Aggies have a huge edge on D, allowing just 302 ypg while Ark is allowing 421 ypg which we think will be the difference and they have an edge on ST's as well. We call for the Aggies to pull this out by a td.

HOUSTON by 24 over Rice - Bayou Bucket Classic dates back to 1971 & schools are only 4 miles apart. HOU has won 6 str (5-1 ATS), incl a 44-7 (-8) win at Rice last year. The Cougars suffered a 48-30 home loss to KAN, in which they all'd 280 yards on the ground & were -2 in TO's. Rice pulled off a home upset vs Louisiana, winning 33-21 as a DD dog (+11'). The Owls held the Cajuns to just 175 ttl yds & forced 4 TO's & have all'd just 219 ypg in their L/2. Rice QB McMahon is hitting 64% with a 7-6 ratio & has been sacked 7 times. This plays into a HOU D line that had 7 sks the first 2 wks, but had 0 last week & should come in with an attitude off their home loss, so we like them to win by over 3 TDs, but this one could be close to the line.

MEMPHIS by 16 over North Texas - 1st mtg since 2003. MEM has won 2 str & is coming off a 44-32 (-14') home win over Ark St. The Tigers held a 547-370 yardage edge, but could not put the game away until late 4Q. MEM is avg 526 ypg their L/2, led by QB Henigan who has eclipsed 350 pass yds in each of the last 2 & has a 6-0 ratio on the yr. The Tigers D has been solid against the run all'g just 3.3 ypc, which incl a gm vs Navy's rush run-heavy option attack. UNT all'd 365 yds on the ground LW, in their 58-27 (-2) loss at UNLV. The Mean Green only trailed 23-20 at HT, but all'd 28 unanswered pts over the last quarter plus. We do not have a strong lean on this one & see the final result close to the opening line.

TULANE by 9 over Southern Miss - SMiss leads series 23-9, but they met close on the 2020 ssn and Tulane (-3') won soundly 66-24 (+200 yds). Tulane is off a big upset of Kansas St (+14) winning 17-10 despite being -2 TO's. SMiss got their 1st win of the ssn over NW St 64-10 (+353 yds, +2 TO's). True frosh QB Wilcke has started the L/2 gms for SMiss & has looked good at times, but our starter Keyes played a little LW and we expect both to play this week. SMiss's D also has 10 sks in 3 gms. Tulane is avg'g 421 ypg/37 ppg on the season & SMiss is giving up 446 ypg/30 ppg to FBS foes. SMiss is also -4 TO's vs FBS foes. The Green Wave are 12-2 ATS record as a HF since 2019, but here is potential for a let down here for Tulane after a big upset last week.

WKU by 33 over Fiu - WKU has allowed just 258 ypg during a 3 game series win streak. LY the 'Toppers were -15' and won 34-19 w/a +290 yard edge. We thought the loss of so many of WKU's key players from LY would be too much to overcome at Indiana last week. WKU proved us wrong, leading for most of the game and they finished with a 545-484 yd edge but lost in OT 33-30 (+6'). Fiu is off a bye after losing to Texas St 41-12 (+13') the week prior. QB Holmberg was inj'd in the opener and missed that game as bkp Grayson James threw 2 picks. Fiu allowed 367 pass in their opener against Bryant and could get picked apart here by D2 transfer Austin Reed who threw for 329 and 2 td's vs Indy. There is no way we are siding with the Panthers who are on a 1-13-1 ATS run vs FBS foes.

UTAH ST by 3 over Unlv - USU has won the L/6 mtgs SU but have gone 3-3 ATS in those games. USU is off a bye week and before they were throttled 35-7 vs Weber St (-118 yds). UNLV is off to a 2-1 start this season & took down N.Tex 58-27 and put up 576 yds incl 365 rush (7.2). UNLV QB Brumfield is hitting 71% (773, 7-1). USU's run defense has not been great this ssn as they are all'g 241 ypg (5.7) and they only have 1 sk in 3 gms, but their pass D is giving up just 54% comp. UNLV's defense did allow 474 yds LW incl 305 pass yds & USU QB Bonner did have a week to get back on track after throwing for just 159 yds the L/2 gms. While we have been impressed with UNLV early on, it is tough to see USU losing this game at home after a week off & they are the dog here.

PURDUE by 17 over Fau - First mtg. Purdue is on 3-6 SU/ATS vs Group of 5 foes while FAU has covered 3 of their last 4 vs Big 10 foes including in '19 when they opened with Ohio St and lost 45-21 as 27 pt dogs. Pur is off an emotional loss to Syracuse after taking a late lead and they've got back-to-back Big 10 road games at Minn and at MD on deck. FAU was no match for rival UCF last week, getting beat 40-14 (+8) and outgained 653-296 but the Owls actually led 14-7 2Q and only trailed 16-14 at half. We have a small lean on the underdog Owls given that Purdue may be looking ahead.

LSU by 24 over New Mexico - First meeting. LSU enters off a home upset win over Miss St 31-16 (+3). The Tigers held the Bulldogs to 289 yds and QB Daniels threw for 210 and rushed for 93. NM is also off an upset win, beating UTEP 27-10 (+2). The Lobos are allowing just 230 ypg so far as Rocky Long as transformed their defense. The Lobos were just 1-7 ATS as double-digit dogs last year but their significantly improved defense will keep them in games. LSU is in a huge sandwich with Auburn on deck. We think NM keeps it closer than expected and with NM only averaging 286 ypg the Under could be in the mix for our Sept Totals GOM!

SAN JOSE ST by 1 over Western Michigan - First mtg was LY and WMich won 23-3 as a 2-pt home dog. SJSt is off of a bye week and 2 wks ago they hung around at Auburn, losing just 24-16 as 24-pt road dogs, while WMich lost at home vs Pitt 34-13, where we won a marquee on the Under 48. Our College Marquee LW went 4-0!! SJSt has struggled to get the offense going (309 ypg/19 ppg) by their D is holding tms to 387 ypg/21 ppg. LW against a talented DEF the Broncos only put up 180 yds & SJSt has a talented & exp'd DLine. WMich's D is also all'g 431 ypg so with an extra week to prepare we think SJSt can get enough from their offense to win a close game.

3★ NEW ENGLAND over Baltimore - The Patriots avoided being 0-2 for the 1st time since way back in 2001 (SB win over the Rams) following a 3 pt win over the Steelers where they finished with a 376-243 yd edge. The Ravens meanwhile blew a 21 pt lead in the 4Q against the Dolphins with MIA getting a GW 7 yd TD pass with :14 left (QB Jackson 437 tti yds & 4 TD). The Patriots have controlled the series in recent years with wins in 4 of the past 5 (3-2 ATS) including a 23-17 home win back in '20. They have also covered 7 of their L/8 when listed as a HD. With BAL failing to cover 5 of their L/6 as a away chalk, an upset in Foxboro could be on the horizon. **FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 6**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Detroit (+) over MINNESOTA - The Lions continue to deliver covers (9-2 ATS run) following a 9 pt win inside of Ford Field against the Commanders where we cashed a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on the Over 48 (QB Goff 256 pass yds & 4 TD). The Vikings meanwhile return home to a MNF trip to take on the Eagles. In their 2nd meeting a year ago in Ford Field, the Lions (+7) picked up a 29-27 upset victory ending an 8-game losing skid in the series. With DET covering 5 of their past 7 against NFC North foes and the Vikings (4-11-1 ATS as a HF) having a trip to London on deck, we expect the visitor to keep this one close. **FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 1**

OTHER PLAYS

Pittsburgh at CLEVELAND - Thursday - Following a surprising 31-30 defeat at home against the Jets where they allowed a pair of TD's in the final 1:22, the Browns take on a Steelers squad that was held to just 243 yds in a 3 pt home loss to the Patriots. After picking up a surprising Wildcard win the year prior at Pittsburgh, the Browns dropped a pair of matchups a ssn ago against the Steelers including a 26-14 road defeat in what would be Big Ben's final home game while PIT is 9-4 ATS against DIV foes and 20-7 ATS as a dog, the absence of Roethlisberger and a charged-up home crowd should give CLE a chance. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Buffalo by 7 over MIAMI - The Bills head back on the road for the 2nd time in '22 following a MNF home matchup against the Titans. They now take on a Dolphins squad that saw QB Tagovailoa throw for 469 yds and 6 TD's (incl GW 7 yd TD w/:14 left) in the 42-38 comeback win (MIA trailed by 21 entering 4Q). The Bills have dominated recent matchups with the Dolphins picking up victories in 7 straight (5-2 ATS) including a 35-0 win LY in South Beach where they had 21-13 FD and 314-216 yd edges. While MIA is on a 9-2 ATS run overall and have covered 8 of their L/11 as a HD, we expect the Bills to get the job done in this one as they are 7-1 ATS vs DIV foes. **Cincinnati by 9 over NY JETS** - Following a 2nd consec rough performance LW in DAL where they were held to just 254 yds in a 20-17 defeat, the Bengals are back on the road for a 2nd consec week to take on a Jets squad that got a pair of late TD's (incl GW w/:22 left) for the comeback win vs CLE LW (QB Flacco 307 pass yds & 4 TD). After picking up 3 consecutive wins from '13-'19, the Bengals (-10) suffered a surprising 34-31 upset LY at MetLife Stadium (NYJ 32-18 FD & 511-318 yd edges). The Jets haven't had much success at home in recent matchups however as their ssn-opening loss to the Ravens has them failing to cover 7 of the past 10 as a HD.

New Orleans by 7 over CAROLINA - This marks the 3rd straight DIV matchup for the Saints to begin the year as they previously got a comeback win in Wk 1 against the Falcons and dropped a 20-10 loss LW against the Bucs (thanks in part to a 5-1 TO deficit (3★ LP Winner on Under 44)). The Panthers dropped a close contest LW on the road against the Giants who connected on a GW 56 yd FG with 3:34 left in the game (QB Mayfield 14-29-145-1-0). While the Panthers have dropped 5 of the last 6 in the series, the lone win did come LY in Charlotte as they picked up a 26-7 victory as a 3 pt dog (Saints held to 6 FD's & 128 yds). The Saints (London on deck) have however gone 19-9 ATS as an AF coming in while CAR has failed to cover 9 straight overall.

Kansas City by 8 over INDIANAPOLIS - The Chiefs head to IND with extra rest following a 3 pt Arrowhead win against the Chargers last Thur (trailed 17-7 in 3Q, huge 99-yd IR TD in 4Q). The Colts on the other hand have had a rough 1st 2 weeks after a tie in Wk 1 over the Texans and a shocking 24-0 defeat LW in JAX (Jags 331-218 yd edge, IND 3-0 TO deficit). In their most recent matchup back in '19, the Colts (+11) went into Arrowhead and picked up a surprising 19-13 victory. While IND is 6-3 ATS as a dog, they have failed to cover 6 of their past 9 home openers. With KC covering 7 of their past 10 overall coming in, we'll give them a small lean in this one.

TENNESSEE by 4 over Las Vegas - The Titans return to Nashville following a MNF trip to BUF. Their 1st HG started off nicely against the Giants as they led 13-0 at HT. The visitor would charge back in the 2H however escaping with the 1 pt win. LV meanwhile comes in with an 0-2 mark following a 20-0 blown HT lead LW at home against the Cardinals in the eventual OT defeat. In their last meeting back in '19, the Titans (-3) went into the former "Black Hole" in Oakland and picked up a 42-21 victory to end a 3-game losing skid in the series (TEN 552-356 yd edge). While LV is a perfect 4-0 ATS as a NDIV AD coming in (won all 4 outright!), the Titans are also likely sitting at 0-2 coming in (expected loss to the Bills) and will have an extra sense of urgency in this one.

WASHINGTON by 1 over Philadelphia - The Eagles head to the Nation's Capital on short rest following a MNF meeting with the Vikings. The Commanders meanwhile are off of a 9 pt road defeat against the Lions where they trailed 22-0 at HT (3.5★ LP Winner on Over 48!). After dropping both contests against WAS the year prior, the Eagles picked up the series sweep in '19 including a 20-16 victory LY in DC. While WAS has gone just 3-8 ATS as a DIV HD, former Eagles' QB Wentz (spent '16-'20 w/PHI) will be ready in this one against a PHI squad that is just 2-6 ATS as an AF and 3-9 ATS inside of the NFC East.

CHICAGO by 7 over Houston - Lovie Smith and the Texans head North to the Windy City to take on his former team that he spent 9 years with as HC. The Texans actually had a 9-6 lead heading into the 4Q LW in DEN before the Broncos got 10 unanswered points in the 16-9 victory (DEN 350-234 yd edge). The Bears also fell LW in Lambeau to the Packers as they were held to just 10 pts and 228 yds (4★ Newsletter win on GB!). After picking up wins in the first 4 of this series, the Texans were dismantled in their last trip to Soldier Field back in '20 as the Bears finished with a 410-263 yd edge in the 36-7 victory. While CHI's offense has eclipsed the 400 yard mark just one time since that win (23 gms), the Texans are just 3-7 ATS as a NDIV AD and have failed to cover 8 of their L/9 against the NFC.

LA CHARGERS by 13 over Jacksonville - The Jaguars evened their ssn record to 1-1 on the year following a 24-0 home win over the rival Colts (QB Lawrence 25-30-235-2-0). The Chargers meanwhile have some extra rest before this home matchup following a 3 pt defeat last Thur in Arrowhead where they finished with a 401-319 yd edge and led 17-7 in the 3Q. The Chargers have done extremely well in this series dating back to '10 with an 8-1 SU mark (0-9 ATS) and the only defeat coming in OT ('17). They have however failed to cover 12 of their past 14 as a NDIV HF. Fortunately for the Chargers, the Jaguars also have some iffy spread records coming in as they've gone just 2-7-1 ATS as an AD while failing to cover 8 of their L/10 overall. Assuming Justin Herbert plays (ribs), we like the Chargers in this one.

TAMPA BAY by 3 over Green Bay - The Packers head South after an easy home win against rival CHI where they had 26-11 FD and 414-228 yd edges. The Bucs meanwhile got another strong effort from their defense (forced 5 TO's) in a 10 pt road win inside of the Superdome (3★ LP Winner on Under 44!). After winning 3 straight from '11-'17, the Packers have dropped 2 consecutive contests including the NFC Championship in '20 where the Bucs (+3) overcame 3 int's by Tom Brady. With TB a solid 8-2 ATS as a HF coming in and the Packers and impressive 8-3 ATS as an AD, we're going to give the Bucs a FG lean and let Vegas decide which directions to lean.

SEATTLE by 1 over Atlanta - The Falcons are out West for a 2nd consecutive week following a close 4 pt loss LW in LA against the Rams where they scored the final 17 pts (key goaline int late cost them a potential win!). The Seahawks on the other hand are back at home for a 2nd time in 3 weeks after a rough trip to the Bay Area against the 49ers where their only points came on a blk'd FG ret'd for a TD (SF 373-216 yd edge, SEA 3-0 TO deficit). In their most recent meeting back in '20, the Seahawks (-1) picked up a 38-25 win despite the Falcons finishing with 28-22 FD and 506-383 yd edges (ATL -2 TO). With ATL a solid 9-3 ATS in NDIV AG's coming in and SEA's offense a major question mark, we expect the visitor to stay within the spread in this one.

San Francisco at DENVER - SNF - Rematch of SB XXIV, a contest that saw the Broncos hammered 55-10 by the heavy favorite 49ers (-12). The 49ers earned their 1st win of the ssn LW at home against the Seahawks (3★ LP Winner on Under 40.5!) although they did lose starting QB Lance for the ssn in the process (QB Garoppolo 13-21-154-1-0 in relief). The Broncos are also sitting at 1-1 on the year after knocking off the Texans (350-234 yd edge) LW in "Mile High". In their most recent meeting back in '18, the 49ers (+3) picked up a 20-14 home upset of the Broncos finishing with a 389-274 yd edge. While SF has gone 8-3 ATS as an AD coming in, also keep in mind that the Broncos have covered 5 of their past 7 matchups against the NFC. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Dallas at NY GIANTS - MNF - This ugly MNF matchup got even uglier with Dak Prescott going down with injury during their Wk 1 loss at home to the Bucs. DAL did however pick up a surprising home upset win over the Bengals as a TD dog LW (GW 50 yd FG as time expired) with bkp QB Rush throwing for 235 yds and a TD. The Giants meanwhile are a surprising 2-0 on the year for the 1st time in 6 yrs after a comeback road win in Nashville and a 3 pt home win a week ago against the Panthers (GW 56 yd FG w/3:34 left). The Cowboys have dominated the Giants in recent years with wins in 9 of the L/10 (8-2 ATS) that includes a 21-6 road victory LY. Most of those victories did however come with Prescott under center.
