**4★ Utah over UCLA** - The Utes have looked unstoppable over their past 4 contests (35 pt avg MOV) including a 42-16 victory LW at home against the Beavers where QB Rising had 272 tll yds and 4 TD (OSU 417-361 yd edge, -4TO's). The Bruins meanwhile remained undefeated last Fri as they led 40-16 entering the 4Q against the Huskies in the eventual 8 pt win (DTR 368 tll yds & 4 TD). In their SLC matchup a year ago, the Utes (-6') rushed for 290 yds and 5 TD's en route to an easy 44-24 victory. That win by Utah was their 5th straight in the series (SU & ATS). With a 27 pt avg MOV in those contests and the Rose Bowl providing little to no support for the Bruins (Utah fans travel well!), the Utes should continue their dominant run against UCLA in this one. **FORECAST: Utah by 14**

**3★ East Carolina over TULANE** - TUL has won 4 of the L/6 vs ECU, but the Pirates dominated LY's matchup at home 52-29 (-3'), as they out'g the Green Wave 612-404. ECU is coming off a 48-28 (-9') win over USF that was moved from Tampa to Boca Raton due to Hurricane Ian. The Pirates out'g'd the Bulls 397-227 in the 1H en route to a 41-7 HT lead. ECU QB Ahlers threw for 465 yds & 6 TDs & now has a 15-3 ratio & the Pirates are a couple missed FGs away from being 5-0. Starting QB Pratt missed w/a lower leg inj (CS) & backup Ibieta was inj'd on the 1st series. The Green Wave were out'g'd 383-273, but got a scoop & score TD from the Def in the 3Q to keep them in the gm & forced OT with a TD with 39 sec left. The opening line has TUL as a slight HF & ECU went 4-0 LY as an AD, so we like the Pirates to get an outright win here. **FORECAST: East Carolina by 7**

**3★ Ohio St over MICHIGAN ST** - OSU has won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) in series & have won the L/8 (7-1 ATS) in East Lansing. OSU is off a 49-10 win vs Rutgers in which they had a 413-187 yd edge, incl a 230-90 yd edge at HT. With starting RB Henderson out (CS), backup RB Williams ran for 191 yds (9 ypc) & tied a OSU record with 5 rush TDs. OSU is currently outscoring their foes by an avg score of 49-15. MSU has lost 3 gms in a row (0-3 ATS), following their 27-13 (+8) loss at Maryland. MSU has not beaten a P5 team yet TY. They are all g 326 pass ypg to P5 foes & come it at #103 in our Pass D rankings, while failing to generate any pressure, as they have only recorded 1 sack the L/3 gms. Ohio St won 56-7 (-19') LY, while out'g'g MSU 655-224. We went against MSU for 3★ LPS in their losses to UW and Minny and we look for another lopsided loss to the Buckeyes. **FORECAST: Ohio St by 35**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ James Madison over ARKANSAS ST** - First mtg. This will be JMU's longest road trip of the season, but going back to 2019 JMU has won 12 straight road reg ssn games SU. JMU hosted TXSt last wk & were up 19-0 HT (260-72 yd edge, 12-2 FD edge) and won 40-13 (+214 yds) while Ark St was also at home vs ULM & won 45-28 as RB Lang scored a TD rushing, receiving & on a KR. The Ark St offense has seen some success & is avg'g 394 ypg/35 ppg incl 254 ypg pass (69%), but they face a JMU DEF all'g just 220 ypg/14 ppg and are holding foes to 212 ypg under their ssn avg (#1 FBS)! The Ark St DEF is allowing foes to gain 44 ypg above their ssn avg (#111 FBS) and JMU is avg'g 462 ypg on offense incl 218 rush (4.5) & QB Centeio is hitting 62% (11-1 ratio). JMU is 4-0 SU/ATS & are +124 pts TY and we think get the win here by over 2 td's. **FORECAST: James Madison by 17**

**2★ UAB over Middle Tennessee** - Rematch of CUSA's 2018 Title game which MT won 27-3. Both teams enter off home losses. UAB was upset by Rice for the 2nd straight ssn, losing 28-24 (-10) but the Blazers held 360-209 yd and 23-14 FD edges. They were up 17-7 at half and a fmlr ret'd swung the game in the 2H. MT allowed 590 yds in their 45-30 (+4') loss to UTSA. QB Cunningham threw for 368 and has a 6-2 ratio in his L/3. UAB has a huge edge on D, holding foes 110 ypg below their avg while MT is allowing 30 ypg more than their foes avg. The Blue Raiders two losses this season have come by 37 & 15. UAB is 20-7-2 ATS at home and we think UAB, who is 5-0 ATS off a SU loss will bounce back and win by over 2 td's. **FORECAST: UAB by 17**

## OTHER GAMES

### FRIDAY OCTOBER 7TH

**Nebraska by 6 over RUTGERS** - NEB has won all 4 B10 mtgs & the visitor has covered in each of those gms. The Huskers come in off a 35-21 (-5') home win over IND. NEB fired their DC over their bye week & it paid dividends, as they all'd just 293 yds to the Hoosiers, after all'g 583 ypg to their first 3 FBS foes. NEB pitched a 2H shutout & scored 2 4Q TDs to get the win. The Knights are off a 49-10 beatdown at Ohio St. RUT actually took a 7-0 after an early 1Q TO, but then allowed 28 unanswered pts in 1H & were out'g'd 413-187 for the game. RUT has been banged up at QB & #3 QB Simon took most of the snaps here & only threw for 74 yds. RUT has lost 20 straight B10 home gms dating back to '17, so we'll back the Huskers and their seemingly revitalized Def here.

**MEMPHIS by 3 over Houston** - MEM has won 5 of 6 SU & 6 of 7 ATS in the series, although HOU won & covered LY at home, out'g the Tigers 461-322 in the 31-13 (-8.5) win. HOU suffered a 27-24 (-2') home loss in OT to TUL, which moved them to 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS on the ssn. The Cougars out'g'd TUL 383-273, but lost a fmlr that was ret'd for a TD & committed 9 penalties (70 yds), which moves their ssn tll to 52, which is the most in the NCAA. MEM moved to 4-1 on the yr (2-3 ATS) on the strength of their 24-3 (-18') home win over Temple. The Tigers only out'g'd the Owls 331-297, but forced 3 ints & held the Owls to 52 yds rushing (2.4). MEM has won & covered the L/3 at home in the series & we think that trend to continues here.

**NEVADA by 7 over Colorado St** - Nev is 3-1 SU/ATS in the L/4 mtgs. However this mtg is much different as former Nev HC Norvell comes back to Reno along with several former Nev players he brought with him to CSU. Nev won their F/2 gms despite failing to gain 300 yds in either gm (+9 TO's!) but have dropped 3 straight gms & have been outgained by 208 ypg in the L/3 gms. Nev's best offensive threat has been RB Taua (350, 4.1). CSU has not fared any better as they are 0-4 SU/ATS & are losing by 30 ppg. The CSU offense is only avg'g 242 ypg/11 ppg, QB Millen is banged up and the OL has all'd 25 sacks (23.4%)! CSU also has had several st'r leave the team in the last few wks, which is a big red flag to us. Both tms are in rough shape, but Nev has actually shown a pulse at times & the players that stuck around will want to stick it to Norvell for leaving.

**SAN JOSE ST by 10 over UNLV** - As MW foes SJSt is 7-2 SU/ATS vs UNLV. LY SJSt's 27-20 win at UNLV broke a 5-0 SU/ATS run by the home team. UNLV is off to a 4-1 SU/ATS start and their offense is putting up 423 ypg/38 ppg led by QB Brumfield (1223, 70%, 8-2), but UNLV has been outgained in 3 of their 4 gms vs FBS foes & they are +9 TO's in their 4 wins. UNLV's OL has also all'd 15 sks (9.4%). SJSt's offense has put up just 368 ypg but did gain 456 yds & scored 33 pts on the road vs a good WF defense LW incl throwing for 314 yds & UNLV's pass D has all'd 268 ypg (63%) vs FBS foes. SJSt has been getting strong play from their DEF all ssn, all'g just 307 ypg/16 ppg and are holding foes to 64 ypg under their ssn avg. We see the Rebels offense getting slowed down by SJSt's defense and the Spartans picking up the home win.

### SATURDAY OCTOBER 8TH

**Duke by 6 over GEORGIA TECH** - GT has won last 2 mtgs but Duke has covered 7 of their last 8 including last year as 4' pt away dogs. Duke led 27-24 4Q but GT drove 88 yds/6 plays for the GW td with :51 left. Last week was Brent Key's first game as Interim HC. He led the Jackets to a 26-21 (+22) upset over a depleted Pitt team in front of a sparse crowd in bad weather. Duke needs 2 more wins to reach a bowl in HC Elko's first ssn after beating UVA 38-17 (-2'). The Blue Devils are +71 ypg while GT is -96. GT had a lot of breaks go there way last week (+3 TO's, -77 yds) and Duke needs this

game bad to reach a bowl as their schedule toughens so we like the Blue Devils to win by under a td. **MARYLAND by 6 over Purdue** - 1st mtg since '19. The home team is 2-0 SU/ATS in their B10 matchups. MARY is off a 27-13 (-8) home win over Mich St, which moved the Terps to 4-1 SU/ATS TY. QB Tagovailoa was banged up the wk prior, but played here & threw for 314 yds (1-0 ratio) & has now thrown for 1416 yds (75.5%) w/a 8-4 ratio TY. PUR is coming off a 20-10 (+11') upset win at MIN to move to 3-2 on the ssn, as the Boilers Def forced 3 ints, incl one in the EZ that preserved their 10-3 HT lead. QB O'Connell returned after missing prvs wk & threw for 199 yds, but was picked twice. MARY has struggled against B10 West foes under HC Locksley, going 0-7 SU & just 1-6 ATS, while PUR is on an 8-3 ATS run vs B10 East opps & while we expect the Terps to get the home win, this one is near the opening line so we do not have a strong lean here.

**Louisville by 10 over VIRGINIA** - UL is out for revenge after blowing a 30-13 4Q lead last year and losing by 1 point. UVA is 6-2 ATS in this series and has won the last 2. UVA continues to struggle under new HC Elliott after a 21 pt loss at Duke LW and they've been held under 300 yds by all 3 P5 foes they've faced. UL QB Cunningham was inj'd and bkp Brock Domann was just 1-8-19-0-1. UL was upset as 13' pt chalk by BC. UVA is 106 ypg vs P5 foes. UL is +58 ypg on the ssn and has ply'd our #5 toughest sked. UL has the edge in all 3 phases. Their Dline has 13 sacks UVA has all'd 13 sks with their rebuilt Oline. The last 6 meetings have gone Under the Total and we like UL to win by double-digits but that hinges on QB Cunningham being available.

**MIAMI, FL by 7 over North Carolina** - NCar has won the L/3 mtgs but LY it was UM who covered as 7' pt dogs. QB Van Dyke was making his first road start and after a rough first half he nearly led the upset. UM down 45-42 drove to the NC16 but a tipped pass was int'd w/.06 left. The 'Canes are fresh off a bye and looking to rebound from B2B losses to A&M & Mid Tenn. Van Dyke was benched in his last start but should have his best start against a NCar pass D that is #121. NC handled VTech 41-10 (-9) with QB Maye throwing for 363 and 3 td's. UM's D allowed 507 yds vs MT but 237 yds came on 3 plays and they held their 2 previous foes under 300 yds. The ACC Coastal is still wide open and we think the 'Canes will play much better off a bye and we think LW's D performance for NCar had more to do with VTech's weak O than any improvements they've made so we like UM by a td.

**Michigan by 20 over INDIANA** - UM has won 18 of the L/19 mtgs, but IU did pull the upset LTH here in '20 with a 38-21 win. IU is off a 35-21 loss (+5') at NEB in which they were shutout in the 2H & held to a ssn low 290 yds & have now lost 2 str & are now on an 0-4 ATS run. MICH is off a hard fought 27-14 (-10') win at Iowa LY. The Wolverines dominated the 1H as they out'g'd Iowa 236-91, but only led 13-0 at HT, as they settled for 2 FGs. The MICH Def is now all'g just 252 ypg. Michigan is 7-3 ATS as a HF since LY, but IND has covered 2 of 3 in the series. The Wolverines are clearly the more talented tm, but the Hoosiers backs are against the wall & our number is pretty close to the line.

**Buffalo by 4 over BOWLING GREEN** - Bulls are looking for revenge as LY Falcons ended a 4 gm series losing streak, shocking the Bulls 56-44 as a 13' pt AD. They did it with big plays (81 & 64 yd td passes & 77 & 47 yd td runs) but were still outgained 499-484. UB opened MAC play 2-0 SU & ATS with wins at EM & LW beating Miami 24-20 as a 3 pt HF getting the GW td w/:31 left. BG opened MAC play LW needing to hold on against winless Akron for a 31-28 win as a 9 pt AF. Both are 2-3 SU but BG's only cover was in their upset of Marshall, while Buffalo is 4-1 ATS, with their only non-cover against undefeated Holy Cross allowing a Hail Mary td as time expired. BG has opened as a HF, a role they are 0-2 ATS 1-1 SU) the L/3 yrs. We'll take the Bulls & the points.

**PITTSBURGH by 21 over Virginia Tech** - Pitt has owned this series, winning the last 3 by 21, 33 & 30 pts and are 13-2 ATS. VT is 0-9 ATS in Acrisure Stadium. The home team is 13-4 ATS. The Panthers were missing two OL starters, their top 2 RB's and playing in sloppy weather with a light crowd LW vs GTech and was upset 26-21. VT enters off a 41-10 (+9) loss at NCar where they were out-gained 527-273. The Hokies are -224 ypg in their L/2 and they avg 131 ypg less than their foes give up which is dead last in the FBS! QB Wells has a 5-6 ratio and faces Pitt's Pass D which ranks #16 (54%, 7-4). Pitt has covered their L/5 off a SU loss and they've played the much tougher sked (#40 vs #106). With series history firmly on their side we like the Panthers to bounce back with a strong win.

**GEORGIA by 27 over Auburn** - UGA is 7-0 SU/ATS when hosting Auburn. Last year the Dawgs were laying 15 pts, the most in series history, and won 34-10 but this year they are laying 29! The Dawgs have now had two straight puzzling performances, only beating Kent St by 17 then nearly getting upset by Missouri in a 26-22 (-29') win where they trailed 13-0 2Q and 22-12 4Q. Aub led 17-0 1H last week vs LSU and finished w/a 438-270 yd edge but had 4 TO's including a fumble ret'd that appeared to be a forward pass. QB Ashford threw for 337 and 2 td's. UGA does have two lopsided wins this year but they were both on the road and Smart is just 13-22 as a HF. This is Aub's first road game and after last week's performance we think they will be competitive for the 1H. **Clemson by 28 over BOSTON COLLEGE** - This is BC's Red Bandana game. Clem has won the last 11 mtgs and has held BC under 300 yards in 8 straight. That is likely to continue with BC putting up just 23 ypg and 317 ypg but they did put up a season high 34 pts and 454 yds LW despite starting two former DL on their OLine. BC's offense ply'd better than expected but were also about to be down 12 3Q but UL had a td called back and then UL lost QB Cunningham. Clem got revenge for LY's loss to NCSt, 30-20 (-6'). The Tigers held the Pack to 279 yds despite missing DT Bressee. QB Ugiagaleihei has an 11-1 ratio and two wks ago BC lost by 30 at FSU. Clem is 10-5-1 as a DD away fav and we don't think the Tigers fall for a letdown.

**Liberty by 28 over MASSACHUSETTS** - The favorite has won & covered all 4 prev meetings with Liberty 3-1. LY Flames dominated, leading 41-3 at HT & winning 62-17 as a 35' pt HF finishing with a 604-284 yd edge. LW Liberty saw their return of QB Salter from a groin injury but he struggled (10-19-170-2-2, -10 rush) & was replaced in the 2H by QB Bennett (7-9-98-1-0). Liberty used the running game with two 100- yd rushers for first time s/2020. While LU never trailed, ODU tied the game at 24 late 3Q before LU pulled away for a 38-24 win (-3'). LW UMass shocking led EM 13-0 early 3Q as a 20 pt AD but trailed 14-13 into 4Q but still easily covered only losing 20-13. While UMass is improving Liberty only has an FCS foe on deck & with no loss of focus wins big.

**KENTUCKY by 13 over South Carolina** - KY is 7-1 SU and has covered 8 of L/9. SC is getting extra rest off a 50-10 win over FCS S Car St last Thur. KY enters off a 22-19 (+6') loss at Ole Miss. The 'Cats are allowing just 297 ypg and held their L/4 foes to their ssn low yds while SC is allowing 402 ypg vs FBS foes. The 'Cats OL has allowed 19 sks (13.5%) but SCar only has 4 sks all ssn. RB Rodriguez ret'd LW and while they only finished w/109 rush, SC allowed over 200 rush to 3 of the 4 FBS foes they've faced. SC is 3-8 as an AD while KY is 12-6 as a HF. SC QB Rattler has thrown 7 ints & faces KY's #28 ranked pass D (50.7%, 2-4). SC is 0-4 ATS in Lexington and we think that trend will continue.

**NC State by 7 over Florida St** - NCSt has won 4 of the last 5 mtgs and are 16-4-1 ATS vs FSU. The 'Noles are 2-4 SU/0-6 ATS in Raleigh. FSU took their 1st loss of the ssn LW, 31-21 (-6') vs WF. The 'Noles were SOD, fumbled, missed 2 fg's and a ssn high 11 pen's. NCSt held Clem to a ssn low 354 yds last week but lost 30-20 (+6'). The 'Pack are holding foes 128 ypg below their avg but FSU is avg 110 ypg more than their foes allow. We think NCSt's ST's edge proves to be the winning factor and will take an angry 'Pack who has cov'd their L/6 off a SU loss.

**Tcu by 3 over KANSAS** - KU is 1-9 SU vs TCU as B12 foes but have covered 7 of 10 incl LY when KU (+21) led 14-7 HT and TCU needed a GW FG with :06 left 4Q to win. KU is off their toughest gm of the ssn LW vs Iowa St where they won 14-11 despite getting outgained by 100 yds & out FD's 20-10, but were held out by 3 missed ISU FG's. TCU hosted Okla & put up 668 yds & 55 pts on OU, while holding them to 355. KU comes in avg'g 420 ypg/42 ppg, but were held to 213 yds LW but that was the best DEF KU has faced all ssn & KU did hold ISU to just 313 yds & KU collected 5 sks. TCU offense is avg'g 550 ypg/22 ppg incl hitting 74% of their passes & do face a KU pass D that has all'd 267 ypg (66%). Gameday will be on hand & that could be a distraction, however, it is tough for us to go against KU as they are 8-0 ATS with QB Daniels as the starter & we think they keep it close.

**FLORIDA by 11 over Missouri** - FL is out for revenge after MO beat them for the 3rd time in 5 years. FL was -8' and held a 360-286 yd edge but lost in OT 24-23. MO nearly pulled a huge upset LW, leading UGA 22-12 4Q but lost by 4 as 29' pt dogs. Since firing their Dline Coach LY, MO has allowed just 130 rush ypg (3.5). Their D is holding foes 97 ypg below their avg. WR Lovett leads the SEC w/460 yds (17.0). FL gets short rest after they had their game vs FCS E Wash delayed to Sunday. The Gators have failed to cover twice as chalk, losing to KY by 10 at home and only beating USF by 3 while getting out'd by 73 yds. FL is allowing 9 ypg more than their foes avg. The last 5 mtgs have gone Under the Total and we think MO's D keeps it within 2 td's.

**CINCINNATI by 26 over Usf** - CIN has won 4 str in the series. LY the #2 ranked Bearcats won at USF 45-28 (-23) with a 506-346 ydg edge. CIN opened AAC play with a 31-21 road win at Tulsa. The Bearcats out'd the Hurricane 364-285, but had to sweat it out late into the 4Q as Tulsa had a couple opportunities to pull within 1 score. USF had their scheduled home gm vs East Carolina relocated to Boca Raton due to Hurricane Ian. The Bulls lost to the Pirates 48-28 (+9'), in a game that wasn't that close as ECU led 41-7 at HT w/a 397-227 yd egde. USF is now 0-14 (5-8-1 ATS) away from home under HC Scott, but USF has covered 6 of 7 in the series, so we'll steer clear here with a line that is around 4 TDs.

**Georgia Southern by 1 over GEORGIA ST** - Since 2015 GSthrn is just 2-5 SU/2-4-1 ATS vs their SBC in-state rival. GSthrn's offense made the move away from the option & are playing well so far, avg'g 500 ypg/38 ppg, are avg'g 315 pass ypg, and have all'd just 2 sks in 235 pass att! While the GSt offense has ran the ball well (214, 4.7) their DEF has all'd 468 ypg the L/4 gms & their pass D comes in ranked #118, all'g 295 ypg (69%) vs non-option tms. GSthrn's DEF is also suspect as they are all'g 444 ypg incl their run D all'g 205 ypg (5.5). While this is GSthrn's 4th road game in 5 wks, we see the Eagles offense out-dueling the GSt offense and winning a close gm.

**Kent St by 2 over MIAMI, OH** - HT is 7-1 SU & 6-2 ATS with 4 of the L/5 being upsets. That includes LY's gm (decided MAC East Champ) with KSU (+1) pulling out a 48-47 OT win stopping MU's 2 pt conv. LW in his 4th start (Gabbert OFY) MU QB Smith threw for 119 yds & rushed for a car high 142 but threw an int that set up a 1 yd UB td drive. Despite a 359-278 yd edge (+1 TO), MU was hurt by 11 penalties incl 1, after holding UB to game tying FG, gave UB a FD & they scored GW td with :31 left. LW KSU had a 736-450 yd edge over Ohio but was -2 TO's & trailed much of game before winning in OT. MU has Def edge (#78-#114) but KSU has Off edge (#44-#114) & played tougher schedule (#32-#93). Still with the series trends & MU facing virtual elimination for MAC East Race (would be losses to top 2 contenders), we look for MU to pull out all the stops here & keep it close.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN by 1 over Eastern Michigan** - EM is 6-5 SU & 8-2-1 ATS in series since '11 including 3 straight outright updetd. LY WM (-5) led 21-9 late 3Q but with TO's on 2 straight possessions allowed 13 unanswered to lose 22-21. Broncos won their MAC opener 4 wks ago coming from behind to beat Ball St 37-30 as a 6' pt HF. LW they blew out New Hampshire 44-7 as a 15 pt HF. Eagles lost their MAC opener 2 wks ago as up 31-30 in 3Q allowed Buffalo to score 20 unanswered. LW they were still in a daze as a 20 pt HF they allowed UMass to lead 13-0 3Q before scoring 20 unanswered. Despite being 3-2 SU EM's only cover was their outright upset of Ariz St, but some of that is due to being 0-3 as a favorite. Here they are in the preferred role as an away dog where they are 21-6 ATS/'16, so as usual we will take the Eagles & the points here.

**Appalachian St by 17 over TEXAS ST** - As SBC foes App St is 5-0 SU vs TXSt, but are just 1-3-1 ATS. This mtg has also gone 'under' the total all 5 gms with an avg of 45 pts scored. App St is off a win vs an FCS foe 49-0 (+322 yds), while TXSt is back home after a 40-13 loss at JMU (-224 yds & -11 FD's). App St also faced JMU and led 28-3, but lost 32-28. App St has faced the tougher schedule (#77 vs #120) as TXSt toughest foe so far was Baylor (42-7 loss) While App St upset Tex A&M on the road. TXSt did allow BU to run for 293 yds (7.9) and App St has ran for 188 ypg (5.0) TY. App St does only have a by on deck so there is no look ahead here, but we feel like this TXSt tm will keep the game within the line & App St has yet to win big vs an FBS foe.

**WAKE FOREST by 10 over Army** - WF won a wild game LY 70-56 (-3) and finished w/a 638-595 yd edge. The Black Knights failed as 8' pt chalk LW, falling behind Georgia St 17-0 at half and lost their better running QB, Tyhier Tyler (ankle). They allowed 299 rush but LY it was their pass D that struggled vs WF when they let QB Hartman throw for 458. WF pulled the upset LW, beat FSU 31-21 (+6'). QB Hartman has a 15-2 ratio and Army allowed UTSS's Harris to throw for 359 in week 2. WF's run D has been improved, allowing 135 (3.8) but did give up 416 (5.9) to Army's option LY and you can't imagine having just ply'd Clem & FSU B2B that they've spent much time working on it. Tyler had 104 rush in

this game LY so his injury may limit the effectiveness of their option and we like WF to win by DD's.

**Kansas St by 6 over IOWA ST** - ISU has won 3 of L/4 mtgs SU & covered 2 straight. KSt is rushing for 267 ypg (6.1) incl 309 ypg (7.0!) in B12 play and LW QB Martinez ran for 171 (14.3, 3 td!) while RB Vaughn ran for 170. However, ISU's rush D is all'g just 118 ypg (3.2) vs B12 foes. The ISU offense is avg'g 332 ypg/18 ppg vs B12 foes and have only ran for 92 yds the L/2 wks and the OL has all'd 9 sks L/2 gms, and the KSt DEF has looked good for much of the ssn (370 ypg/18 ppg) and collected 6 sks LW. The KSt pass D has all'd 345 ypg (69%) vs B12 foes, but have 9 int's on the ssn & KSt overall is +9 TO's TY, while ISU is -3 TO's the L/2 gms. KSt also has a big edge on ST's (#7 vs #97). KSt already showed they are capable of winning a tough B12 road gm TY & HC Klieman is 3-0 ATS as an AF here.

**BOISE ST by 10 over Fresno St** - This matchup has lost some shine since the season began as Fresno is likely w/o QB Haener (check status) and Boise lost QB Bachmeier. Boise St has won the L/2 mtgs vs Fresno, both being outright upsets! Boise's new QB was rFr Taylen Green & he is a dual-threat talent and LW Boise put up 450 yds incl 316 rush (7.2) vs SDSt with QB Green rushing for 105 (13.1!) and RB Holani rushing for 131 (7.7!). The Fresno offense struggled last week w/o QB Haener, putting up just 187 yds in a loss at UConn! Here they face a Boise DEF that is holding foes to 74 ypg under their ssn avg & all'g just 236 ypg (11 sks L/4 gms). Boise's pass D is also all'g just 134 ypg (48%). This is Fresno's 3rd straight road game while Boise is at home again & looked to get some of their swagger back LW at home. We'll call for Boise by DD's here.

**OHIO by 15 over Akron** - Ohio had won 13 of L/14 incl 8 by DD's. Ohio's defense has been a sieve TY (#128) allowing 42 ppg & 578 ypg. Akron is only slightly better (#120) allowing 38 ppg & 470 ypg. Ohio has shown some life on Off (#95) with 29 ppg & 423 ypg while Akron has not (#117) with just 15 ppg & 321 ypg. Ohio is off a tough OT loss to Kent St, where they only trailed once (7-0) in regulation easily covering as an 11' pt AD. LW Akron as a 9 pt HD trailed BG, 10-0, 17-7, 24-14 & 31-21 before scoring the backdoor cover td mid-4Q to only lose 31-28. While the Zips are on a 5-2 ATS run in the series, Ohio has covered 2 of L/3 & their only non-cover was a 24-10 win in '20 as a 27' pt HF. Ohio is the better team & if less than a 2 td favorite we will take them.

**Air Force by 17 over UTAH ST** - From '15-21 AF was 5-1 SU/5-0-1 ATS vs USU, but LY the Aggies (+9) pulled the outright upset 49-45 on the road. However this is not the same USU tm as they are just 1-4 SU/ATS TY and QB Bonner is OFY, so rFr Cooper Legas is now the starter. LY USU gave up 437 rush (6.9) to AF & their run D TY is all'g 188 ypg (4.8) and their DL is banged up. AF on the other hand looks like the best tm in the MW as they are avg'g 370 rush ypg (6.3) led by RB Roberts (573, 6.3, 7 td) and their D is all'g just 279 ypg & holding foes to 55 ypg under their ssn avg. USU is also -10 TO's in their L/3 gms. AF is 3-1 ATS the L/2Y as an AF & with USU reeling right now, we have no issues backing a strong AF team to win by over 2 td's.

**Oregon by 16 over ARIZONA** - AZ continue to alternate wins and losses in '22 (SU & ATS) following a 23 pt home win over the reeling Buffs (QB de Laura tied school record with 6 TD passes). UO has won 4 straight since their embarrassing WJ 1 loss vs UGA (QB Nix 302 tlyds & 4 TD). Although Oregon has won 9 of their L/12 against Ariz (6-5-1 ATS) including a 41-19 (-29) win LY in Autzen where Ariz had 31-17 FD and 435-393 yd edges (-5 TO, UO 17 unanswered 4Q pts). The biggest issue for Ariz could be their rush D that's allowed 264 ypg (6.9) over the past 3 gms vs a Ducks' run game that put up 351 (9.5) on the ground a week ago.

**USC by 11 over Washington St** - The Trojans are off a 17 pt win over the Sun Devils where QB Williams threw for 348 yds and 3 TD's. The Cougars meanwhile finished with 21-13 FD and 415-311 yd edges in their 28-9 (-4) win over Cal. In their Pullman meeting a year ago, the Trojans (-7') overcame an early 14-0 deficit by scoring 45 unanswered pts in the 31 pt victory (4★ LP Winner on USC, 24-15 FD & 447-279 yd edges!). While the Trojans have won 12 of the L/14 in the series (9-5 ATS), they are just 3-9 ATS against the P12 overall. The Cougars meanwhile are an outstanding 9-1-1 ATS inside of the conf and nearly upset the Ducks a few wks back.

**Washington by 17 over ARIZONA ST** - The '22 ssn continues to go downhill for the Sun Devils following a 17 pt road loss to the Trojans (USC 29-20 FD & 485-331 yd edges). The Huskies meanwhile head into Tempe with extra rest after a rough matchup in Pasadena where they trailed by 24 going into the 4Q (QB Penix 33-48-345-4-2). ASU does have an advantage in series matchups against UW with wins in 12 of the L/14 (13-1 ATS). LY's contest did see the Sun Devils overcome a 24-14 deficit in the 4Q by scoring 3 TD's in the final frame (Huskies backdoor TD pass w/0:03 left). Despite that recent success and an 8-4 ATS mark as a HD, we expect the visitor (4-1 ATS TY) to get back on track and pick up a convincing win.

## ULM +14' over Coastal Carolina

**ULM (+) over Coastal Carolina** - As SBC foes CC is just 1-3 SU vs ULM but that win came LY when CC won 59-6 (557-203 yd edge). ULM traveled to Ark St LW and lost 45-28 (just -65 yds & -4 FD's) as they held Ark St to 355 yds (all'd KR td). CC hosted GSthrn LW & scored the GW TD with :38 left 4Q to win. ULM's rush D did allow 273 rush (7.0) to Bama, but vs their other 4 foes all'd just 99 rush ypg (3.1)! CC's DEF is holding foes to 81 ypg under their ssn avg (#25 FBS) and are all'g just 113 rush ypg (3.2) but are all'g 277 pass ypg. The ULM offense is only avg'g 318 ypg/18 ppg but did put up 419 vs a good LA squad 2 wks ago. ULM has also faced the tougher sked (#9 vs #115). While we aren't calling for the outright upset, ULM is 4-1 SU/ATS at home as an underdog under Bowden & CC is off an emotional comeback win. **FORECAST: Coastal Carolina by 4**

**Oregon St by 13 over STANFORD** - Following an 18 pt loss in Autzen LW against the Ducks where they were outgained 515-332, the Cardinal return to "The Farm" having won just one of their past 11 contests (Colgate) and are 0-11 ATS. The Beavers meanwhile have dropped 2 straight after their 3-0 start as Utah scored 21 unanswered points in the 28 pt victory (OSU -4 TO's). The Cardinal are 11-1 SU in this series including 5 straight in Palo Alto. They did however struggle LY in Corvallis with the Beavers (-12') finishing with 29-15 FD and 475-230 yd edges in a 35-14 victory. While OSU did go 0-3 SU/ATS as an AF LY, the Cardinal have also gone 1-5 ATS as a HD in addition to their previously mentioned spread issues.

**Mississippi by 17 over VANDERBILT** - The home team is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in this series with the 'Dores covering 15 of the L/22. Ole Miss was -36 last year in their home finale but only won 31-17 with yds nearly even. The 'Dores enter fresh off a bye after getting beat down by Bama 55-3 the wk prior. Ole Miss pulled out a 22-19 win over KY (-6'). True frosh RB Judkins has topped 100 3 of the L/4 (98 yds in the other). Vandy's true frosh QB AJ Swann has a 6-0 ratio. UM has 16 sks but Vandy only gave up 1 in 4 gms until allowing 5 vs Bama. The Rebels did cover in their only spot as an AF this year, blowing out GT 42-0 but that Jackets team was a mess and Vandy is improved and off a bye so this is a good spot to take a big underdog.

**Tennessee by 7 over LSU** - Tenn has lost the last 5 mtgs though these two last met in '17 with LSU covering as 16 pt chalk (30-10 win). The Vols have the benefit of coming off a bye after their win over Florida 2 wks ago. LSU was thoroughly dominated in the stats LW vs Auburn. They trailed 17-0 2Q, got a fumble ret td and a td pass w/ 15' left to get back in the game and won 21-17 (-8). The Tigers were outgained 438-270 and QB Daniels finished just 8-20 for 80 yards. Tenn's D has struggled vs dual threat QB's but they were up 17 4Q vs UF two weeks ago before giving up two late td's and if Robbie Ashford can throw for 337 vs LSU's pass D, then we think Hendon Hooker (39-3 ratio 2Y) will have a huge game. This game is being ply'd at 11 AM CT so the crowd will be just waking up to see what we think will be a Vols win in a high scoring game.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 13 over Texas Tech** - LY OSU's 23-0 win (-10) at TT snapped a 5-0 ATS run by TT in this series. OSU is off a road win at BU last week where they were up 23-3 3Q, and won 36-25 despite all'g 301 yds in the 2H (119 yds came on 2 long td passes). OSU did find success running LW (166, 3.6) vs a BU run D that had all'd just 80 ypg (2.6) the F/4 gms & TT did allow 343 rush yds (8.8) LW to KT. ST is throwing the ball well, avg'g 362 pass ypg (#4 FBS) but QB Smith has thrown 7 int's already this ssn & the TT OL has all'd 17 sks the L/4 gms and now face an OSU DL that is one of the best in the country. OSU was 4-1 ATS at home vs B12 foes LY and we see their offense coming to life, their D forcing a key TO or two & OSU winning by almost 2 td's here.

**† Texas by 3 over Oklahoma** - From '13-'19 Texas covered 6 of 7 mtgs as the dog, but the L/2 yrs OU has won & covered. OU comes into this gm reeling as they have started 0-2 in Big 12 play as they have all'd 589 ypg/48 ppg vs B12 foes and also lost QB Gabriel in the 2Q (in concussion protocol, status ? as of presstime). The bkp QB for OU is David Beville (Pitt transfer) who saw limited snaps at Pitt & now could be making 1st start here. Meanwhile Texas could get QB Ewers back & their offense is avg'g 444 ypg/38 ppg the L/3 gms led by RB Robinson (513, 5.8, 8 td). The Texas D is playing well (367 ypg all'd) and are holding foes to 108 ypg under their ssn avg (#13 FBS). This is the first time Texas will be the favorite since '09, and we see them winning, but expect OU to keep this rivalry gm close.

**ALABAMA by 27 over Texas A&M** - Bama is out for revenge after Jimbo's Aggies pulled a 41-38 upset as 18 pt dogs LY. The Tide may have to do it w/o Heisman winning QB Bryce Young who was inj'd LW in Bama's 49-26 (-17) win over Ark. RB Gibbs stepped up with a 206 rush yd performance with 2 long 4Q td's. A&M allowed a ssn high 473 yds LW at Miss St in a 42-24 (-4) loss but did allow a blk'd fg ret'd for td and a pick 6 late 4Q. A&M is putting up 83 ypg less than their foes allow on avg while Bama is avg 145 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. A lot of talk will be made of Fisher and Saban's offsn spat, but on the field Bama is just a better team, although QB Young's injury drops our lean under 4 td's.

**TROY by 9 over Southern Miss** - First mtg as SBC foes, but these tms last met LY and Troy trailed 3-0 HT but scored 21 straight pts & won 21-9 (held SMISS to 156 yds). Troy did upset WKU last wk 34-27, snapping WKU's streak of 30+ pts scored in a game at 18 gms. Troy QB Watson did leave the game with inj (status ?) but the bkp is veteran QB Doegoe & he threw 2 td's. SMISS is getting after the QB (12 sks L/3 gms) and their pass D ranks #38, but this Troy pass attack is avg'g 331 ypg (65%). While SMISS is 3-0 ATS as a dog TY, we have been impressed with Troy TY as they are holding foes to 98 ypg under their ssn avg (#15 FBS) and are all'g just 96 rush ypg (2.7) the L/4 gms & have 10 sks the L/2 gms & Troy is 4-0 ATS this ssn vs FBS foes.

**MISSISSIPPI ST by 1 over Arkansas** - HC Pittman is 2-0 SU vs Mike Leach, having pulled an upset as a 17 pt dog LTH then won by a fg LY. The home team is 2-8 ATS in this series. Ark lost QB Jefferson last wk to a head injury. The Hogs fell behind 28-0, got back within 5 but ultimately lost 49-26 (+17). Ark was outg'd 555-377 but did have a 27-17 FD edge. Miss St had a blk'd fg ret for td and a pick 6 in their 42-24 win over A&M. Miss St is holding foes 80 ypg below their avg, led by CB Forbes who leads 3 int's and 4 pbu's. Given Jefferson's inj concerns we can't pick the Hogs to win but HC Pittman is 6-2 as an away dog so we say take the points.

**Wisconsin by 17 over NORTHWESTERN** - NWEST has covered 6 of 8 in the series, but WISC dominated LY with a 497-239 yd edge in their 35-7 (-24') home win. The Badgers have lost 3 of 4 (0-3 ATS) after their 34-10 (-7) home loss to Illinois, which cost longtime HC Chryst his job. WISC alum Jim Leonard was promoted from DC to lead the Badgers the rest of the ssn. His #1 task will be to fix a WISC Off that was held to 208 tt yds, incl just 2 yds on the ground (24 atts, 0.1 ypc) LW. QB Mertz continued to be ineffective as he completed just 17-32 with 2 ints & now has just an 8-5 ratio this ssn. NWEST has lost 4 str (1-3 ATS) after their 17-7 (25') loss at Penn St in which they were outg'd 360-241. The Wildcats pulled within 14-7 in 3Q, but were stopped at the PSU 1 early 4Q which sealed their fate. The Badgers need a win to keep any BIG10 West Title hopes alive, so we'll take them to rebound here & get their interim HC his first career win.

**ILLINOIS by 6 over Iowa** - Iowa has won 13 of 14 in the series & the L/8 in a row, incl a 33-23 (-12') home win LY. Iowa is off a physical 27-13 (+10') home loss to MICH that moves them to 3-2 on the yr. The Hawkeyes held the Wolverines to 327 tt yds, 130 yds below their ssn avg, but only mustered 281 yds of their own, with just 35 yds on the ground (1.5 ypc). QB Petras passed for 246

ILL at 4-1 is off to their best start since starting 6-0 way back in 2012, after a huge 34-10 (+6') road win road at WISC, as HC Bielema took down his former team in Madison. The Illini held the Badgers to just 208 tt yds, incl only 2 yds (0.1 ypc) on the ground & had 5 sks. The ILL Def is only all'g 70 rush ypg on the ssn & now has 14 sks in their L/3 gms. The Illini also have our #1 Pass Eff Def, all'g 159 ypg with 8 ints! While Iowa has dominated the series, we expect the ILL Def to put the clamps on a subpar Iowa Off & put an end to the Hawkeyes series winning streak.

**Tulsa by 3 over NAVY** - Navy is on a 6-1 SU/ATS run in the series, but Tulsa did win 19-6 (-12) LTH in 2020, as they held the Navy option rush attack to just 126 yds (2.4 ypc). Navy, however, rebounded LY in Tulsa as they rushed for 302 (5.0 ypc) in a 20-17 (+11) road win. The Midshipmen come in off a 13-10 (+14) loss to service academy rival Air Force. The Middies were held to just 114 rush yds (3.2), while surrendering 200 (4.3) on the ground. Tulsa is off a 31-21 (+11') loss to CIN, which delivered as a Power Sweep Underdog POW! Tulsa was outg'd 364-285, but had a chance to pull within a FG late 4Q, but were stopped on downs at the CIN 1. QB Brinn came into the gm with an ankle inj, so that's something to keep an eye on here. Despite the Middies series success, this Tulsa squad knows how to win in Annapolis, so we like them to escape with a close victory.

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 10 over Ball St** - CM has won 5 of L/7 but Ball St is 4-3 ATS & the Visitor has won & covered 5 straight. These teams are coming off very different games. LW Ball St (+4') trailed NIU 21-0 2Q & 38-28 late 4Q but tied the game at 38 w/:36 left & won in 2 OT 44-38 for an uplifting win. CM (+7) trailed Toledo 31-3 at HT but after getting within 31-17 early 4Q fell 38-17 for a disappointing loss. CM has the edge on both Off (#69-#112) & Def (#104-#118) despite playing the tougher schedule (#69-#96). CM has only once had back to back MAC losses under HC McElwain and look for them to rebound here against a team that needed some luck LW.

**Toledo by 1 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS** - Huskies are 9-3 SU & 7-4-1 ATS in series s/'10 & LY as a 12' pt AD kicked the GW fg w/:26 left to win 22-20. LW NIU (-4) led Ball St 21-0 2Q & 38-28 late 4Q but allowed Ball St to do what NIU did in many gms LY, come back late & NIU missed a would be GW FG in the first OT & could not match BSU's td in the 2 OT. Rockets after a disappointing loss at San Diego St took no prisoners LW leading CM 31-3 at HT cruising to a 38-17 win as a 7 pt HF. Despite being without starting QB Lombardi L/2 wks NIU put up 23 pts & 327 yds vs Kentucky & 38 pts & 526 yds LW. RB Wayne rushed for 230 yds LW (7.6 ypc), which should help them against a UT team allowing 4.1 ypc. This is a must win for NIU or they will be 3 gms (tiebreaker) behind UT in the West & with a big HC crowd at Huskie Stadium, we will take NIU & the points.

**UTSA by 7 over Wku** - This is a rematch of LY's CUSA Title game. UTSA actually won both of LY's meetings, 52-46 and 49-41 and their were 2,358 total yds in the 2 mtgs. UTSA put up over 500 yds for the 4th time in 5 games LW, beating Middle Tenn 45-30 (-4). Both WR's De'Corian Clark and Joshua Cephus have over 500 yds and Zakhari Franklin isn't far behind with 491. WKU had their 18 gm streak of putting 30+ pts up broken LW in their 34-27 (-5) loss to Troy. The 'Toppers wouldn't have been so close if it weren't for a flukey 4th down play deep in WKU territory where their OL caught a pass and ran for a FD on an eventual td drive. UTSA has a banged up Oline and WKU's pass D has been surprisingly good (#33, 60%, 7-9) along with 15 sacks. UTSA has ply'd the tougher sked (#66 vs #127) and we think the 'Toppers suffer yet another close loss.

**Connecticut by 3 over Fiu** - Shockingly these two downtrodden programs both come in after breaking long losing streaks. UConn had lost 18 straight until they beat Fresno St as 23 pt dogs. FIU ended their 20 game losing streak vs FBS foes by winning at NMex St 21-7 (+14'). FIU got QB James back from inj and he threw 3 td's. UConn was facing a team traveling across the country w/a bkp QB. Fiu is at home and they didn't have nearly as good a situation last week so our lean is with the home dog.

**Utep by 3 over LOUISIANA TECH** - UTEP is 8-4 ATS vs LT including two straight covers and pulled the outright upset LY 19-3 (+6'). The Miners were 0-26-1 SU all-time playing on the East Coast but beat Charlotte 41-35 (-3) last week. The Miners led 24-7 at half and 41-21 4Q after a 100 yd fmb! ret td. LT is fresh off a bye after losing their first 3 vs FBS foes by 28, 28 & 24. The Miners are playing much better after a 1-3 start. LT has ply'd the tougher sked but UTEP has a big edge on D, holding foes 15 ypg below their avg while LT is allowing 93 ypg more than their foes avg which should be enough to give them a 3 pt edge.

**Wyoming by 1 over NEW MEXICO** - NMex has covered the L/3 mtgs & have pulled the outright upset in the L/2. LW NMex jumped out to a 17-0 lead on UNLV (152 yds on F/4 drives) but put up just 145 yds for the rest of the gm & lost 31-20. WY is off a loss at home vs SJSU where they lost 33-16 (-203 yds, -15 FD's). WY's offense the L/4 gms is only avg'g 292 ypg and are holding foes to 41 ypg under their ssn avg at home. While NMex is only avg'g 202 ypg/15 ppg vs FBS foes on offense, the WY DEF has not looked like itself as they are all'g 450 ypg/32 ppg vs FBS foes. We expect this to be a low scoring gm as the L/4 mtgs have averaged just 29 ppg & we'll call for WY to win a close game.

**† Notre Dame by 6 over Byu** - Played in Las Vegas. Both are coming of 10+ win seasons LY, but have been slowed by injuries this year as ND lost their starting QB & BYU has had a laundry list of inj's each week as their top 2 returning WR's having missed a comb'd 7 gms TY. ND is off a bye after a 45-32 win at UNC 2 wks ago as a 2' pt AD. After a depleted BYU was no match for Oregon, they have won the L/2 vs MW teams but failed to cover a 21+ pt HF's. While very close on offense (ND #28-#31) the Irish have the edge on defense (#5-#46) holding two top 10 offenses (Ohio St & UNC) to their season lowest offensive output. That has us taking the Irish as an under td favorite.

**SAN DIEGO ST by 20 over Hawaii** - While SDSSt is having their struggles, UH could be the worst tm in the FBS TY, they are 1-4 SU and in their win vs FCS Duquesne, they were -180 yds & -11 FD's. SDSSt's offense is avg'g just 200 ypg and fired their OC. UH's defense is all'g foes to gain 109 ypg above their ssn avg (#129 FBS) and they are all'g 261 rush ypg (6.9). While SDSSt is only avg'g 66 pass ypg (#130 FBS) they have shown the ability to still run the ball well (192, 5.1) and with their QB situation unknown (QB's Burmeister & Crum both left LW vs Boise) they will likely rely on their run game here. While we like SDSSt to win by almost 3 td's, that is right near the line & that is fine with us.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ San Francisco over CAROLINA** - The 49ers are back on the road on short rest after a MNF home meeting against DIV rival LAR. CAR on the other hand are home for the 3rd straight wk following a 10 pt loss to ARZ where they were held to just 11 FD's and 220 yds. In their most recent meeting back in '19, the 49ers (-5) picked up an easy 51-13 win with 24-12 FD and 388-230 yd edges. With SF posting a solid 15-9 ATS mark as a NDIV AF and CAR failing to cover 10 of their L/11, the visitor gets the edge in this one. **FORECAST: San Francisco by 14**

**3★ Tennessee over WASHINGTON** - The Commanders have had their share of struggles over the past 3 weeks that includes a 15 pt loss LW in DAL where the Cowboys delivered a 3.5★ Top Play LP Winner! The Titans on the other hand moved to 2-2 on the year after picking up a 24-17 road upset at rival IND (Colts 365-243 yd edge, -3 TO's). In their last meeting back in '18, the Titans (-10) picked up a 25-16 victory. With TEN able to go all out here with a bye on deck and WAS failing to cover 6 of their past 9 dating back to LY, we expect the visitor to pick up the victory in this one. **FORECAST: Tennessee by 13**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Houston over JACKSONVILLE** - This marks the only HG in a 4-wk span for JAX who suffered an 8 pt loss LW in PHI (3★ Newsletter Winner on the Eagles, JAX outgained 401-219, 5-1 TO deficit). The Texans meanwhile were dealt a 10 pt home defeat by the Chargers who actually had a 21-0 lead halfway thru the 2Q. The Jaguars haven't tasted victory in this DIV rivalry since 2017 as the Texans have won 8 straight (6-2 ATS) with a 13 pt avg MOV. The Jags have also failed to cover each of their L/3 gms as a DIV HF (incl LY to HOU). We'll call for the Texans to win outright in this one as they're 7-2 ATS inside of the AFC South and 9-3-1 ATS before a bye. **FORECAST: Houston by 3**

## OTHER PLAYS

**Indianapolis at DENVER - Thursday** - The Broncos and Colts last met back in '19 with IND (-5) picking up the narrow 15-13 victory with a GW 51-yd FG with :22 remaining. That final score resembles plenty of the Broncos games so far this ssn as they've been held to just 14 ppg and 306 ypg so far this year at home. LW we picked up a 4★ Newsletter Winner going against DEN with the Raiders picking up the 9 pt victory (LV 25-12 FD & 385-299 yd edge). The Colts were also in DIV play a week ago against the Titans with the visitor handing them an upset defeat. While the Colts did go a perfect 5-0 ATS as a NDIV AD a year ago, it will be interesting to see if the Broncos finally get their offense clicking in front of a rowdy "Mile High" crowd. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**† Green Bay by 10 over Ny Giants - London.** This marks the 1st time in London history that a game is played between two teams who have winning records. The Packers head across the pond for the 1st time in franchise history following an OT win over the Patriots (GB 443-271 yd edge). The Giants are making their 3rd trip to London with wins against MIA ('07, 1st ever reg ssn gm in UK) and the Rams ('16) in the past. The Giants picked up an 8 pt home win LW over the Bears. The Packers have come out victorious in each of the past 3 meetings against the Giants including a 31-13 road win back in '19 where Aaron Rodgers threw for 4 TD's. With the Giants failing to cover 7 of their L/10 overall and going just 1-6 ATS as a dog, the Packers should get the decisive win in this one.

**NEW ORLEANS by 1 over Seattle** - The Saints are back inside of the Superdome following a 3 pt defeat in London against the Vikings where they were without QB Winston, RB Kamara and WR Thomas (missed game-tying 61-yd FG as time expired). The Seahawks meanwhile are back on the road for a 2nd consec week after a 3 pt shootout victory at DET where QB Smith threw for 320 yds (3 tl TD). The Saints have picked up 3 consecutive victories against the Seahawks including a pair of wins in the Pacific NW in '19 (+4) and LY (-4). They have however gone just 1-4 ATS in NDIV HG's while also failing to cover 3 of their 4 matchups in '22. With SEA covering 6 of their L/7 as a NDIV AD, we expect them to hang around to the bitter end.

**BUFFALO by 16 over Pittsburgh** - Following a surprising 24-20 home loss to the Jets (NY GW 2-yd TD run w/ :18 left) where rookie QB Pickett started the 2H over Trubisky (10-13-120, 3 int, 2 rush TD), the Steelers head into BUF to take on a Bills squad that returns from a 2-gm road trip that saw them tripped up in South Beach against the Dolphins (31-15 FD & 497-212 yd edges) and overcome a 20-3 deficit in the 2Q LW at BAL (GW 21-yd FG as time expired). In their Wk 1 matchup a year ago, the Steelers (+6) came into BUF and picked up a surprising 23-16 upset victory despite FD (22-16) and yard (371-252) disadvantages. While BUF does have a big road matchup on deck with the Chiefs and PIT has covered 16 of their L/24 as an AD (outright upset of CIN back in Wk 1 as a TD dog), we're leaning with the home squad here (10-5 ATS as a HF including an easy 41-7 winner over the Titans back in Wk 2) against a rookie potentially making his 1st career start.

**TAMPA BAY by 13 over Atlanta** - After a 2nd straight loss a week ago against the Chiefs, where they were gashed for 41 pts and 417 yds (had allowed just 24 tl pts thru 3 gms!), the Bucs are back at home for a 3rd consec week to take on a Falcons squad that picked up a narrow 3 pt win a week ago at home against the Browns (CLE 403-333 yd edge). The Bucs have dominated the past 2 years with a 4-0 SU (3-1 ATS) mark and a 14 pt avg MOV. They have also covered 4 of their past 6 contests against NFC South foes. While the Falcons have gone a perfect 4-0 ATS this ssn, we're expecting a much healthier Bucs (8-4 ATS as a HF) to drop the hammer in this one and get a comfortable victory.

**MINNESOTA by 10 over Chicago** - Following a narrow 3 pt win in London against the Saints (K Joseph 5-5 FG's), the Vikings are back at home hosting their 3rd DIV foe already this ssn (2-0 SU/1-1 ATS) in the Bears who were held to just 12 pts in an 8 pt loss at the Giants. After winning 4 straight from '18-'19, the Bears have now dropped 3 of the L/4 including LY's trip to MIN where the Vikings (-4) overcame a 14-3 HT deficit in the eventual 14 pt win (CHI 24-11 FD & 356-331 yd edges). While playing a game a week after heading across the pond has been rare (teams usually have a bye after going to England), we like the Vikings here as the Bears have gone just 1-7 ATS against NFC North foes coming in.

**Miami by 7 over NY JETS** - The Jets return home following a comeback win on the road against the Steelers (trailed by 10 in 4Q) in the 1st start of the ssn for QB Wilson (18-36-252-1-2, TD rec). The Dolphins on the other hand suffered their 1st loss of the ssn last Thur in Cincy with QB Tagovailoa being stretched off the field (bkp Bridgewater 14-23-193-1-1). The Dolphins have picked up 4 consecutive wins over the Jets (14 pt avg MOV) including a 24-17 road win a year ago. With the Jets failing to cover 7 of their L/8 inside of the AFC East coming in and MIA 6-2 ATS in DIV AG's, so we have no issue leaning with the visitor in this one no matter who is under center (Dolphins on a 10-3 ATS run!).

**CLEVELAND by 3 over La Chargers** - Following a narrow road loss to the Falcons (key int thrown by Brissett late in 4Q, CLE 403-333 yd edge), the Browns return home to take on a Chargers squad that moved to 2-2 on the year after a 10 pt road win against the Texans (RB Ekeler 109 tl yds & 3 TD). The Chargers have knocked off the Browns in 4 of the past 5 meetings including a 47-42 shootout win LY in a contest that featured 1,024 yds of tl offense. While the offensive output will likely be more limited this time around, injuries continue to mount for the visiting Chargers which could allow the HD to steal away a win here.

**NEW ENGLAND by 1 over Detroit** - After a 3 pt home loss against the Seahawks a week ago where they allowed 48 pts and 555 yds, the Lions head into Foxboro to take on Matt Patricia (DET HC from '18-'20, current OC w/NE) and the Patriots who lost in OT LW in Lambeau with 3rd string QB Zappe (10-15-99-1-0) playing a good portion of the contest. The Lions ended a 4-game losing streak in their last meeting back in '18 with dominating FD (25-12) and yard (414-209) edges. While NE is 13-6 ATS as a NDIV HF heading in (CS on QB's Jones and Hoyer), the Lions have a bye on deck and continue to fight throughout every contest.
