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

The Ravens and Texans meet in the postseason for the 2nd time, with the previous one coming here back in Jan of 2012 where HOU was +88 yards but were -4 TO's and lost 20-13. BAL is off a bye and prior to their Wk 18 loss vs PIT, they had won 6 in a row (5-1 ATS). HOU meanwhile is off a drubbing of CLE at home last week 45-14 where they were just +32 yds but were helped out by two pick-6's on B2B possessions. These teams faced each other in their season opener in BAL where the Texans held a 268-265 yd edge and were +1 TO and trailed just 7-6 HT but lost 25-9.

This marks the 11th trip to the playoffs for BAL under HC Harbaugh (11-9 SU) but the Ravens have just 1 win in their last 4 trips to the playoffs (WC win at TEN in '20) and have not made it past the Divisional Round since the year they won the Super Bowl in 2012.

After HOU went 11-38-1 from '20-'22 the Texans found their way back to the playoffs this season led by Rookie of the Year favorite CJ Stroud and 1st year HC Ryans. This is HOU's 7th trip to the playoffs in franchise history but have never made it past this round. Their last trip to the Divisional Round was '19 where HOU jumped out to a 24-0 1H lead at KC only to give up 41 straight pts in a 51-31 loss.

Coming into '23 many predicted HOU to finish near the bottom of the AFC as they had won just 11 gms the previous 3 ssn's and had a rookie QB and first-time HC taking over. HOU started the season 3-4 but would then go on to win 7 of their L/10 gms with 2 of those losses coming w/o QB Stroud (concussion in NYJ loss). However the Ravens come in well-rested having not played key starters 2 wks ago vs PIT and getting a bye week. HOU is riding their rookie QB and have a lot of momentum but the Ravens D allowed just 301 ypg and will face a HOU offense that avg's just 97 rush ypg (3.7) and QB Stroud will have to face a tough BAL secondary all g just 192 ypg. BAL is laying over a td but we see them as the stronger team and at home like them by DD's.

This is the 10th meeting between GB and SF in the playoffs. SF has won the last four playoff meetings. They handed GB a loss in Lambeau as 5' pt dogs in the '21 Divisional Round, 13-10. That loss was GB's last trip to the playoffs entering this season. GB is 9-9 all-time in the Divisional round and they've won 3 of their L/4 in '16, '19 & '20. SF has reached the playoffs for the 3rd straight year. The 49ers have won their last 6 trips to the Divisional round.

GB snuck in the playoffs as the #7 seed with a 9-8 record. They were 7 pt dogs against Dallas in the Wild Card. The Packers jumped all over the Cowboys with a 27-0 Q2 lead. Jordan Love threw for 272 yards and 3 td's and the Packers led 48-16 before the Cowboys added two late td's for a misleading 48-32 final. GB has won 7 of their last 9 (6-3 ATS).

SF is the top seed in the NFC with a 12-5 record. The 49ers have winning streaks of 5 and 6 games this year but did lose 2 of their last 3 down the stretch. SF is +94 ypg and +134 ypg at home. Christian McCaffrey led the NFL in rushing this season with a career high 1,459 (5.4) and 27 td's. The 49ers boast two 1,000 yard WR's and Brock Purdy was #4 in completion percentage. The 49ers' D allows 18 ppg and 304 ypg. SF is well rested, coming off the bye week and sat most of their key players in the snn finale but they've failed to cover their last five in Levi's Stadium.

Jordan Love has been red hot, with a 21-1 ratio in his last 8 games. The Packers offense has actually been better on the road, averaging 25 ppg and 346 ypg. SF puts up 29 ppg and 398 ypg. The 'Over' is 7-2-1 in GB's road games and 5-3 in SF's home games. The Packers did ultimately give up a season high 510 yards last week and face the 49ers' excellent trio of skill players in McCaffrey, Samuel and Aiyuk. The Vegas Total opened at 50 and with both offenses clicking we will call for a high scoring game and take the Over!

These two last met in the playoffs in 1997 when the Bucs ended a 15 year playoff drought and beat the Lions 20-10. This is TB's 4th straight trip to the playoffs and they are 4-3 all-time in the Divisional round. Detroit just won their first playoff game since 1991 which was also their last trip to the Divisional round. These two met in week 5 when TB was held to 251 yards and 13 FD's in a 20-6 (+3) loss. Jared Goff threw for 353 yards and 2 td's while Baker Mayfield only completed 51% with an int. TB is on a 9-2-1 ATS run and they are coming off a 32-9 win over Philly in the Wild Card. The Bucs finished with a 426-276 yd edge. Det held off LAR last week 24-23 (-3). The Lions never trailed but did get outgained 425-334.

The Bucs followed up their 3rd straight NFC crown with a wild card win over Philly last week. TB started 4-7 but have won six of their last seven. They were +1 ppg and -31 ypg in the regular season. QB Mayfield was battling ankle and rib injuries but they didn't seem to affect him last week when he threw for 337 yards and 3 td's vs Philly. The Bucs defense gave up 21 ppg and 362 ypg on the road this season.

Det ended a six year playoff hiatus this year. The Lions started 8-2 but did lose three of their last seven. They went 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS, +9 ppg and +94 ypg in Ford Field in the regular season. The Lions D allows just 89 rush ypg (3.7) and face a Bucs offense that avg just 88 (3.4).

The Lions already own a 14 point win over the Bucs and that came on the road. They will be playing in front of a fired up home crowd in Ford Field, hoping to see Detroit win in the Divisional round since 1991! Both teams come in red hot, with Detroit covering 5 straight while Tampa Bay has covered 5 of their last 6. The Lions already dispatched the Rams who came in having won 7 of their last 8. We will call for another strong performance by Detroit, who is 6 point home favorites.
