AFC Divisional: Cincinnati at Tennessee. 4:30pm ET CBS.

1★ OVER 47/1★ Tenn (-3.5). TENNESSEE 27 Cincinnati 22. Cincinnati got their first playoff win in more than three decades last week as they held off Las Vegas 26-19. Cincinnati did get out-gained 385-308 and Las Vegas did average 0.4 yards per play more. However, it did come at a cost as Cincinnati's defensive line suffered multiple injuries in the game. DT Larry Ogunjobi (12 TFL's) was placed on IR while DE Trey Hendrickson (14 sacks) is still going through concussion protocol. Meanwhile, the Titans come in off a bye. It was much needed as the Titans were one of the most injury-prone teams in the NFL this year. They used an NFL-record 91 players in the regular season. The expectation is that they will see the return of RB Derrick Henry here. Henry hasn't played since Halloween and we wonder if he will have some limitation. Amazingly, the Titans went 6-2 SU with Henry and 6-3 SU without him as the running game only took a slight hit. Totals' players note the OVER was on a 28-10 run in Tennessee games with Henry and QB Tannehill in the line-up. According to Marc Lawrence's Playbook, home teams with rest in the divisional round are 100-34 SU and 71-59-4 ATS since 1988. Tennessee won 8 games vs teams with a winning record this season. That's more than any team in NFL history! Head coach Mike Vrabel is 8-0 SU in his career with extra-rest (excludes Week 1). We lean Tennessee and the OVER.

NFC Divisional: San Francisco at Green Bay. 8:15pm ET FOX.

1★ Green Bay (-6). GREEN BAY 28 San Francisco 20. The 49ers got the outright win for us on these pages last week in Dallas. They were the only underdog to cover all weekend. San Francisco got it done on the ground with Mitchell (96 yards) and Samuel (72 yards) and should have success here vs a questionable GB rush defense. The 49ers have won and covered 8 of their last 10 games but this isn't a great spot for them playing their third straight road game. Each of their last two games have gone down to the final play in must-win situations. Going back further it is the 49ers 6th road game in the last 8 weeks. Early week reports have San Francisco QB Jimmy Garoppolo banged up (right thumb and right shoulder) along with LB Fred Warner (ankle) and DL Nick Bosa (concussion). Meanwhile, the Packers are hopeful they could get back CB Jaire Alexander and DL Za'Darius Smith on defense. The Packers were 8-0 SU and 7-1 ATS at home this season and the early forecast has temps in the teens for the boys from California. According to Marc Lawrence's Playbook, teams who won outright as underdogs in the Wildcard round are just 6-30 SU

Sunday, January 23rd

NFC Divisional: L.A. Rams at Tampa Bay. 3:00pm ET NBC.

1★ L.A. Rams (+3). TAMPA BAY 24 L.A. Rams 23. The Rams are playing on short rest after dispatching the Cardinals on MNF. L.A. outgained Arizona (375-183) and QB Stafford finally got his first playoff win as a starter after being in the league for 13 years. Meanwhile, the Bucs cashed on these pages for us in their 31-15 win over the Eagles as they led 31-0 before Philly got a couple of garbage-time TD's. We were shocked to see all the money come against Tampa as the line dropped from TB -8.5 down to -7 leading up to kickoff. Tampa is 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS at home this year while the Rams have routinely been good away from home under McVay including 7-2 SU this year. On the injury front, Tampa Bay saw center Ryan Jensen and RT Tristan Wirfs go down vs Philadelphia and their status will be determined Friday according to HC Arians. The Bucs allowed 4 sacks in the game last week and the Rams are one of the last teams you want to face when banged up on the OL. It's never ideal fading Brady in the playoffs but the Rams are 2-0 SU against him the last two years.

AFC Divisional: Buffalo at Kansas City. 6:30pm ET CBS.

2★ KANSAS CITY (-2). KANSAS CITY 30 Buffalo 26. We get the AFC Championship game a week early as the winner here will be a favorite in next week's game regardless if they're hosting Cincinnati or on the road at Tennessee. These are the two best teams in the AFC. Buffalo got the better of KC here back on October 10th as they won 38-20 as 3-point underdogs. Note the Bills were +4 in TO's in that game. That coming on the heels of KC beating Buffalo 38-24 in the AFC Championship game a year ago here. The Bills just had the NFL's 1st ever perfect offensive game. No punts, No picks. No fumbles lost. No field goals. Just touchdowns on every single drive of the game (7) until the kneel downs. QB Allen was 21 of 25 for 308 yards and 5 TD's. Statistically speaking, the Bills are the best team in the NFL as they are No. 1 in ppg margin and yards per play margin. All 12 of their wins have come by 12 points or more and they are on a 4-0-1 ATS run in their last 5 games as they've out-scored their opponents by 18 ppg. On the other side, after falling behind the Steelers early, the Chiefs scored 35 straight points in only 11:31 of game action en route to the blowout win. QB Mahomes was 30 of 39 for 404 yards and 5 TD's. Speaking of Mahomes, he is 7-2 SU in the playoffs in his career with the only two losses coming to Tom Brady. The Chiefs offense gets the headlines but the defense has allowed just 16.5 ppg the last 11 games (10-1 SU). The early money is on the Bills in this game but we disagree and will take KC. Remember, the Chiefs were 3-point home favorites vs Buffalo in the first match-up this year. Since that game, Buffalo is 8-5 SU while KC is 11-2 SU. That's too much of an adjustment to Buffalo's recent hot streak.
