Georgia 47 - SOUTH CAROLINA 10 - (12:00 EDT) -- Line opened at Georgia minus 17½, and is now minus 24½. Pundits stuck the 'Dawgs with the #4 slot in preseason polls. Not a bad spot, but a bit of a demotion following LY's National Title. Losing 9 starters from the best "D" in the nation shouldn't be dismissed, but all doubts were absolved with 49-3 opening day rout of always respected Oregon, followed by allowing just 3 FDs & 19 RYs in wipeout of Samford. 'Cocks have a **495-119 RY deficit** for the season.

RATING: GEORGIA 89

Byu 38 - OREGON 24 - (3:30) -- Line opened at Oregon minus 6, and is now minus 3½. Sure, we missed 2½ pts since this one opened, but still no staying away from this Cougar outfit which is on a **22-3 SU run**, while holding a **239-166 pt edge** in its last 7 lined games. The 'Ducks have been one of the true powers over the last decade plus, but 7 losses in their last 18 games SU, with an accompanying **6-13 spread** log an omen to be sure. Won't do enough vs Coog "D" which held Baylor to 289 yds. Byu a **10-4 dog**.

NOTRE DAME 21 - California 20 - (2:30) -- Line opened at NotreDame minus 14½, and is now minus 10½. Obvious change in the spread, with the loss of QB Buchner (shoulder). Not only that, but new head coach Freeman is still to taste a win, standing at 0-3 SU (loss to Okla St in LY's Fiesta Bowl, blowing a 3-TD lead in the process). Their opening week draining loss to OhioSt hasn't helped, with ensuing setback by Marshall (219-130 RY deficit) just about destroying any enthusiasm for this new season. To wire.

RATING: CALIFORNIA 88

Western Kentucky 40 - INDIANA 27 - (12:00) -- Line opened at Indiana minus 9, and is now minus 6½. Law of averages sure proved out with the Hoosiers as a prime example. Posted a 14-4 spread run in '19 & '20, before LY's horrid **1-10** line skein (only cover by a single pt), which should have been extended on opening day 23-20 (-2) win, despite 29-20 FD & 216-32 RY deficits, had it not been for a horrid endzone reception call. The Hilltoppers on an **8-1-1 ATS run (10-1 SU)**, topping 40 pts in 10-of-11.

RATING: WESTERN KENTUCKY 88

SYRACUSE 41 - Purdue 31 - (12:00) -- Line opened at Purdue minus 1, and is still minus 1. Well, the Boilermakers seem to have picked up where they left off a year ago, with a narrow 35-31 loss to PennSt (98-70 RY deficit), followed by LY's stomping of IndianaSt, as O'Connell was 4/0 (17-of-19). The 'Cuse is in possession of 2 of the most electrifying players in the land in QB Shrader (20-of-23 & 3/0 for 287 yds, who can take it the distance himself) & RB Tucker, who shattered all Orange RY records LY. 'Cuse!

BUFFALO 33 - Tennessee 17 - (7:15 Monday - ESPN) -- Line opened at Buffalo minus 7½, and is now minus 10. No, we're not exactly fans of the NFL double digit chalk setup, but that's how this one shook out, following the early action. Taking the defending champs in such overwhelming fashion only served to cement the Bills' status as simply the best, behind the leadership of Allen, who passed & ran for 5 TDs vs the Rams, with the addition of Von Miller simply fortifying already brilliant "D". Bills a few scores to settle.
